B.Sc. Nursing Course <u>Rules & Regulations</u>

- 1. This is the 2nd examination for entrance to B.Sc. Nursing course, due to non fulfillment of seats providing students an opportunity to pursue the course. Application form shall be available on the website (www.kgmcindia.edu, www.kgmu.org) from 12th July, 2013.
- 2. Admission to B.Sc. Nursing Course in the following Nursing Colleges, which are affiliated to the University, will be made on the basis of entrance examination scheduled to be held on Monday 12th August, 2013.
 - i. Vivekanand College of Nursing, Lucknow.
 - ii. Sahara College of Nursing, Lucknow.
 - iii. Rama College of Nursing, Kanpur.
 - iv. Apex College of Nursing, Varanasi.
 - v. Dr. Tandon College of Nursing, Agra.
 - vi. Samarpan College of Nursing, Chinhat, Dewa Road, Lucknow.
 - vii. G.S.R.M. College of Nursing, Sarojini Nagar, Lucknow.

The selection of the candidates will be strictly based on the merit of the entrance examination and preference of the college given by candidate.

- 3. Minimum age for admission is 17 years on or before 31st December of the year 2013.
- 4. Minimum qualifications for admission is
 - a. Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years)
 - or
 - b. Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (10+2)

or

- c. An equivalent examination with 12 years schooling from a recognised board or University with Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) with English with a minimum 45% aggregate marks.
- 5. Duration of Course is four years.
- 6. Both males and females are eligible. Vivekanand and Sahara have seats for females only.
- 7. Candidates must be medically fit additional medical check up may done before admission (the candidates who are in the merit list are required to submit certificate of physical fitness from registered medical practioner).
- 8. Candidates for the entrance test will have to deposit a fee of Rs. 1500/- (Rs. 1200/for SC/ST) through Bank Draft/Banker's Cheque payable to the Controller of Examinations, K.G. Medical University, U.P., Lucknow, along with the prescribed application form duly filled in.

9. Subjects for the written test are Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English and General Knowledge of Intermediate standard.

- 10. No T.A./D.A. will for attending be paid the Entrance Examination/Interview/Counseling.
- 11. Implementation of changes in regard to admission process/selection criteria etc. will be incorporated as per INC notification issued from time to.

- 12. Any dispute in regard to any matter referred to herewith shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Allahabad High Court of Judicature, Lucknow Bench only.
- 13. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final in the matter of selection of candidates for admission to the course and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.
- 14. There is no provision for rechecking of answer sheets or communication of marks obtained at the entrance examination. Result of the entrance shall be available at the website of the University.
- 15. **Distribution of the seats:-** Seats in different nursing colleges are available. The exact number in each college can be ascertained only after the 1st batch of students join. Category wise distribution of seats will be as per UP Public Service Commission Scheduled Caste, Schedule tribes and other Backward Class Reservation amendment ordinance 2002.
- 16. Seats may be increased or decreased at the time of counseling on the directives of the hon'ble Vice Chancellor.
- 17. In the event of more than one candidate securing same marks, the merit will be decided on the basis of highest marks obtained by the candidate in the examination as per the following order: i) Higher marks in Biology, ii) Chemistry, iii) Physics,
- iv) Intermediate examination.

18. Counseling Procedure:-

- i) Counseling shall be held at K.G. Medical University, U.P., Lucknow on 20th August, 2013.
- ii) A non refundable fee of Rs. 300/- will have to be submitted through Bank Draft in favour of **'Controller of Examination'** payable at Lucknow.
- iii) A separate Bank Draft of Rs. 5,000/- in favour of controller of Examination, payable at Lucknow shall have to be deposited by the candidates at the time of counseling, on award of seat.
- iv) The Bank Draft of Rs. 5,000/- shall be returned to candidate on his/her joining of any one of Nursing Courses. However, if the candidate opts for seat and does not join then University has the right to forfeit that money.
