



BILATERAL AGREEMENT

between

King George's Medical University U.P (India)


and

Lithuanian University of Health Science, Kaunas (Lithuania)

Vice-Chancellor of King George's Medical University, UP (India) Prof. Devendra K. Gupta and Rector of Lithuanian University of Health Sciences, Kaunas (Lithuania) Prof. Remigijus Žaliūnas have decided to enter in an agreement. The agreement is aimed in cooperation and contribution to the field of medical science and development of education between King George's Medical University and Lithuanian University of Health Sciences (hereinafter referred to as the Parties).

The Parties have agreed on the following:


1. On the basis of common interests, agreed to promote bilateral cooperation in medical research and education:
 - a) Teaching and exchange of scientific researchers;
 - b) Development of projects of common interests;
 - c) Scientific and educational exchange on the basis of common interests;
 - d) Organizing lectures, seminars and scientific meetings;
 - e) Medical doctors, residents exchange;
2. Apart from this contract, future areas of cooperation and the result specifications can be defined in addition to agreement with applicable rules, which must be approved by each institution.
3. Both institutions will work together jointly in projects of mutual interest, taking into consideration other institutions and international projects.
4. The contract is made in English language in two copies with equal legal force, one copy for each Party. The contract shall enter into force after being signed by both Parties for a non defined period.
