Press Release- KGMU (1)

Dr. Gurmeet Singh, Ex Medical Superintendent of GM & Associated Hospitals, KGMU, who had resigned from the post of Professorship in Anaesthesiology and joined as Medical Superintendent, Gandhi Memorial & Associated Hospitals had filed a writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court Allahabad, Lucknow Bench Lucknow after his retirement from the post of Medical Superintendent when faculty retirement age was increased to 62 years, pleading that he should be retired at the age of 60 years and should be given the benefits of the increase in age which is applicable to present faculty of King Georges Medical University as he was also one of the faculty before he resigned to join as Medical Superintendent.

The Hon'ble High Court, Lucknow Bench, Lucknow in its judgement dated 18th May, 2016 has dismissed his writ petition and has held that Dr. Gurmeet Singh is not entitled for the benefits of the age increase in retirement as a faculty of KGMU.

The State Government of Uttar Pradesh and Nagar Nigam, Lucknow has issued orders that the land behind the Queen Merry Hospitals adjacent to Pata Nala does not belong to Nagar Nigam and ordered that since the land is entered in Khasra/ Khatauni of King George's Medical University, therefore, in view of the public interest and need of expansion of the Medical University, the occupants of the land should vacate at the earliest. The land occupied by the members of the Balmiki Mahasabha vacated the land and shifted to Duda Houses in larger public interest paving the way for the expansion of the Medical University and Queen Marry Hospitals.

The shopkeepers on Shahmina Road filed a writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, Lucknow saying that the said order of the Lucknow Nagar Nigam to vacate the land should be stayed in the interest of the shop owners. The Hon'ble High Court in its historical judgement passed on 17th Mary, 2016 held that the title_of the said land is in favour of King Goerge's Medical University and Nagar Nigam has no right to allot this land to any other party and dismissed the writ petition without granting stay on vacation.
