Department of Community Medicine of King George's Medical University has also received 48 doses (24 vials of 2 doses each) of Yellow Fever Vaccine and the diluents from Central Research Institute, Kasauli, Himachal Pradesh alongwith the revised guidelines for Yellow Fever Vaccination issued by Directorate General of Health Services (International Health Section), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India.

Department of Community Medicine, King George's Medical University has made necessary arrangements for starting and running a Yellow Fever Vaccination Centre as per guidelines and intend to start the centre on 15 December 2016.
