On line Application procedure INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Application shall be submitted online only, admit card will be available online it self.
2. Online Application can be submitted on website www.kemcindia.edu, or www.kemu.org
3. First register and create **Login ID and Password** on the website as directed and keep it for all future correspondence.
4. Fill all the entries in the application form carefully and check them before final submission as **wrongly filled, or incomplete application forms will be rejected** and no enquiry will be entertained regarding this.
5. Please take a printout of the completed application form.
6. Login with the same **Login ID and Password** will be required for obtaining the Admit Card

Examination-

1. Candidates will be allowed to enter in the examination Hall only on presentation of admit card.
2. Examination will be of **180 minutes** duration and will start at **11:00 AM to 2.00 PM**.
3. Candidates are required to be present at the examination center **60 minutes** before the commencement of the examination and to be seated 30 minutes before the time of examination.
4. No candidate will be allowed to enter in the examination hall **15 minutes** after the seating time. Candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall only after completion of examination.
5. Candidates shall sign the attendance sheet when directed to do so by the Invigilators.
6. Candidates shall not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written matter or bits of paper or any other material except the admit card inside the examination hall. Pagers, cellular phones and electronic gadgets of any kind are strictly prohibited in the examination hall and shall be treated as use of unfair means. **Candidates are advised not to bring these in the Examination Hall as there is no provision for safe keeping.**
7. **Examination will be on MCQ basis (200) in English language only.**
8. **The MCQ will have "One Correct option". There shall be no Negative Marking.**
9. **Subjects/Questions for the written test shall be B.Sc Nursing Course level.**
10. Candidates shall observe strict silence during their paper. Any disturbance in the examination hall shall be deemed as misbehavior and the defaulter candidate shall forfeit the right to continue in the examination hall. The decision of the **Center Superintendent** shall be final.
11. **Candidates shall enter the roll number on the top of the question booklet and no where else. Rough work, if any, may be done on the question booklet and not on the response sheet.**
12. **The question booklet along with the response sheet have to be deposited with the Invigilator of the examination hall after the completion of examination.**
13. No candidate should leave his/her seat of the examination hall without the permission of the Invigilator until he/she finally submits the question booklet and response sheet to the invigilator.
14. No candidate shall copy from the paper of any other candidate or permit his/her own papers to be copied or attempt to give or attempt to obtain irregular assistance of any description.
15. The question booklet and response sheet are not to be taken out of the examination hall under any condition.
16. **USE BALL PEN ONLY (BLUE OR BLACK) provided by us.**
17. Candidate should be careful while filling the circle provided in the answer sheet. The answer sheet shall be read by **OMR Technology** and marks awarded shall be final and no representation shall be entertained.
18. Candidate should ensure that the question booklet provided to him contains all the pages intact within 10 minutes of commencement of the examination.

Failure to maintain the discipline and to observe these instructions at the time of examination/admission shall disqualify the candidate from taking the present examination/admission and also from subsequent examination.

Rules & Regulations

1. Admission to M. Sc Nursing Course in the College of Nursing, KGMU, Lucknow and following Nursing Colleges, which are affiliated to the University, will be made on the basis of Entrance examination scheduled to be held on 13.09.2020 (Sunday) at Lucknow.

- i. Institute of Nursing, KGMU, Lucknow.
- ii. Vivekanand College of Nursing, Lucknow.

The selection of the candidates will be strictly based on the merit of the Entrance Examination and preference of the college given by the candidate. Reservation Rules of U.P, Government shall be applied.

2. Minimum qualifications for admission are:-

Eligibility Criteria/Admission Requirements: These are per criteria INC regulation. In case you don't fulfill the same please do not apply. The eligibility will be checked at the time of Counselling. No request for refund of money deposited once shall be entertained.

- i. The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- ii. The minimum education requirements shall be the passing of :
B.Sc Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- iii. The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc Nursing/ B.Sc Hons. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an Institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- iv. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc Nursing.
- v. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc Nursing.
- vi. 5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates may be given.

3. Duration of Course is two years.

4. Both males and females are eligible. **Vivekananda College** of Nursing have seats for **female** candidates only.

5. Candidates must be medically fit. Additional medical checkup may be done before admission (the candidates who are in the merit list are required to submit certificate of physical fitness from registered medical practitioner).

6. Candidates for the entrance test will have to pay a fee of **Rs 3000/- for Gen and Rs.2000/- for SC/ST/OBC** payable through Indian Bank or HDFC Bank, along with the prescribed application form duly filled in.

7. **Payment of Examination Fee:**

a) By Credit card /Debit card (Master/Visa card only) or Net banking till 31.08.2020 (Monday) Candidate can directly proceed filling of application form after payment.

b) Candidate can also deposit cash through bank Challan of Indian Bank/ HDFC Bank till 28.08.2020 (Friday). For this first download bank Challan from website www.kgmu.org and deposit the examination fee in any branch of Indian Bank or HDFC Bank branch in India. The Candidate will be provided a receipt with transaction ID number on its deposition. It is required to upload scanned copy of this Bank receipt, with mentioning this transaction ID for filling the application form. In case of payment by bank Challan candidates are required to re-login with their login ID and Password. Two working days after making payment, candidate will be able to **fill the application form**. Candidate required to send **scanned copy of bank receipt** ready for filling the application form at this stage. No T.A./D.A. will be paid for attending the Entrance Examination/Interview/Counselling.

8. Implementation of changes in regard to admission process/selection criteria etc. will be incorporated as per INC notification issued from time to time.
9. Any dispute in regard to any matter referred to herewith shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Allahabad High Court of Judicature, Lucknow Bench only.
10. **Total Questions will be 200, it will be divided in two sections. Section A contains 1-120 and Section B from 121 to 200. In case of tie in marks the resolution shall be as: (A) Marks obtained in Section –A, then, (B) Higher age of candidate.**
11. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final in the matter of selection of candidates for admission to the course and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.
12. There is no provision for rechecking of answer sheets or communication of marks obtained at the Entrance Examination. Result of the entrance shall be available at the website of the University.
13. **Scrutiny: However scrutiny is permissible on payment of Rs 500/- in either of the Bank Account certified or by Demand Draft in favor of “K.G.M.U B.Sc Nursing-2015” payable at Lucknow. The candidate can opt for scrutiny within 48 hours of declaration of the result.**
14. **Distribution of the seats:-** Seats in College of Nursing KGMU, and affiliated Nursing Colleges are available (as per details attached). Category wise distribution of seats will be as per UP Public Service Commission Scheduled Caste, Schedule Tribes and Other Backward Class Reservation Amendment Ordinance 2020. **OBC certificate issued after 31st March ~~2019~~ 2020 shall only be valid.**
15. Seats may be increased or decreased at the time of counselling on the directives of the **Hon’ble Vice Chancellor.**
16. **Counselling Procedure:-**
 - a) Counselling shall be held at K.G. Medical University U.P., Lucknow:
(1) 26.09.2020.(Saturday) ,(2)Please visit website. (3) Please visit website.
 - b) **All original documents and eligibly of candidate shall be certified.**
 - c) A non refundable fee of Rs. 500/- have to be submitted through Bank Draft in favor of ‘**Finance Officer, KGMU**’ payable at Lucknow, at the time of Counselling.
 - d) A separate Bank Draft of Rs. 5,000/- in favor of **Finance Officer, KGMU** payable at Lucknow have to be deposited by the candidates at the time of counselling, on award of seat.
 - e) The Bank Draft of Rs. 5,000/- shall be returned to candidate on his/her joining of any one of Nursing Courses. However, if the candidate opts for seat and does not join then University will forfeit that money.
