The following components need to be ensured by HOD, NSV Centre :

1. All NSV training centres have to complete all Induction, refresher and District TOT batches with 100% strength by nominating atleast 6-8 MOs in each batch to ensure presence of 4 MOs in each batch.
2. None of the centre has fulfilled the criteria of 50 NSV cases per month hence, Innovative Coordinators and Training Coordinators have to work together in strategic manner to get atleast 5 NSV cases per day to ensure adequate case load for practice of trainees.
3. The role of urban and rural ASHA is crucial as 60-95% of cases have been motivated by them in all NSV centres except Lucknow till Aug,18 report of NSV client data. Kindly conduct rigorous meetings with both Urban and rural ASHAs in regular manner to tap the opportunity to institutionalised the NSV client motivation. Do inform ASHAs about the benefit of NSV technique, compensation package and also ensure speedy transfer of such benefit payment both to client and motivator as per financial rules and regulation. Also, conduct other client motivation activities as well.
4. Kindly upload the training and NSV beneficiary client data on www.upfamilyplanning.in portal on weekly basis and also ensure that figures of NSV cases being uploaded on HMIS portal also.

Please feel free to contact Dy. General Manager (BD/CT), SIFPSA head quarter for any clarity and support in the implementation of the project during working hours.

3. **Performance tracking:** You are requested to track the performance of doctors trained at your centre for atleast 6 months through support staff and share the information with SIFPSA.

 - The funds will be kept in a separate bank account and operated by at least two officials jointly for each Institute.
 - The grant-in-aid should be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned. The assets acquired out of the grant should not without the prior sanction of the Government of India be disposed of, encumbered or utilized for any purpose other than for which the grant is sanctioned.
 - The grant is subject to the conditions and principles laid down in Rule 206 to 212 of the General financial Rules, 2005 and instructions there under, modified from time to time as well as other specific conditions that may be circulated from time to time.

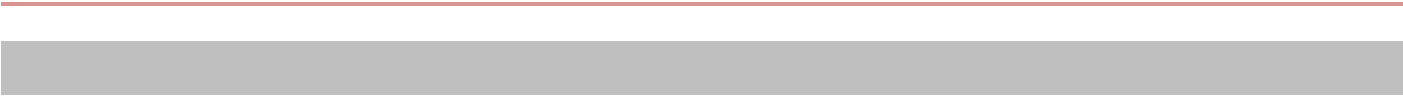

Objective of The Proposal

- Identity congenital birth defects of face, cleft lip and palate PAN india.
- Established NATION WIDE data of spectrum of problems of cleft patients, protocols of treatment given to these children and their actual treatment needs.
- Ascertain risk factors associated with congenital birth defects of face: nutritional environmental and generic.
- Identity of risk factors.
- Develop strategies to minimize risk factors thereby reduction in incidence of CLP anomaly. Develop protocols for interdisciplinary care which is feasible and affordable in India with minimum burden to patient, parents and service providers.
- Improve treatment outcome.
- The ultimate aim is to improve the quality (QOL) of children suffering from Cleft lip palate and such deformities so that these children can have a better living.
- Ultimate objectives are to be able to initiate a National registry for the patients with congenital birth defects of the face and jaws and to establish strategies that will address multitude of challenges associated with the prevention and treatment of this deformity.
- The study will lead to formulate NATIONAL guidelines for the treatment of these birth defects.
- The outcome will lead us the way for:
Quantify issues and problems in delivery of cleft in India.
Plan strategies for the prevention and reduction of this anomaly
Plan and implement multispecialty quality care suited to Indian scenario Outline required focused research.

Methodology

The study is being conducted at Post Graduate Department of Plastic Surgery, King George Medical University, Lucknow.

- **Inclusion criteria of patients which have been taken for project**
 - Congenital non- syndromic cleft lip and/ or palate patients within the age limit of 0 to 2yrs and 5yrs to 14 yrs irrespective of sex.
- **Exclusion Criteria**
 - Other syndromic cleft lip and/or palate or defects which are non congenital e.g. traumatic, infective
- Informed written consent was taken before enrolling the patient in study.
- Each patient taken in the study is subjected to the following investigations, all of which are non-invasive type. Evaluation of the patient using the specially designed proforma under the following aspects of cleft care:
 - General details: The personal details like patients name and address, contact details were recorded.
 - Socio-demographic profile.
 - Evaluation of the risk factors associated with etiology of cleft.

- Dental status of cleft patients and their orthodontic treatment profile.
 - Evaluation of primary and secondary cleft deformity.
 - Assessment of tympanic membrane.
 - Hearing and speech evaluation.
- The patient's extra oral and intraoral standard clinical photographs is being recorded. Study models of needed patients above 5 years of age is being prepared using alginate impression material.
 - The complete list of the parameters studied in the project is long and is beyond the scope of discussion. Here, only a few of the parameters is being used to evaluate the secondary cleft deformity are discussed.
 - The cleft deformity is being evaluated by a plastic surgeon. Cases with primary and secondary cleft deformities is being evaluated on separate parameters.
 - Cases with secondary cleft deformity are assessed for the overall lip appearance, overall appearance of the nose, presence of palatal fistula and function of the soft palate.
 - Overall lip appearance is being judged on the basis of the lip symmetry, thickness of the vermilion border, presence of crosshatches across the scar line and the width (length of the scar). The lips is being classified as poor repair, fair, good, very good and excellent.
 - The appearance of the nose depended upon the nasal symmetry, deviation of the tip of the nose and nasal septum, length of the columella, width and symmetry of the alar bases, among other factors. The nose repair was classified as poor repair, fair, good, very good and excellent.
 - The length of the soft palate is being judged subjectively by asking the patient to open the mouth wide and say "aaaahhhh" repetitively while observing the elevation of the soft palate during this maneuver. The soft palates is being classified as short or adequate in length.
 - Assessment of tympanic membrane has been done by an ENT surgeon using an otoscope. The tympanic membranes were classified as normal, retracted or perforated.
 - In each patient, both ears are examined irrespective of the side or type of cleft. In cases with an intact tympanic membrane, assessment of hearing was done in both ears using a combined pure tone and impedance audiometry unit (Interacoustics, USA).
 - The cases are classified according to the presence or absence of hearing loss and the type of hearing loss, i.e., conductive, sensorineural and mixed type.
 - Speech assessment has been done by a speech therapist and each subject was assessed for hypernasality and overall speech intelligibility. Assessment of hypernasality is subjective and classified as present or absent. Speech intelligibility was assessed using a standardized scale.
 - The orthodontic treatment need is assessed using GOSLON Yardstick according to the criteria defined by Mars et al.[9] and grouped into categories 1-5.

Interim modification of objectives / methodology (with Justification)

New Notification for study of 50 patients with Congenital non- syndromic cleft lip and/ or palate patients within the age limit of 0 to 2yrs irrespective of sex , were added in 2019-20.

Title:

“Cleft Lip Palate Anomaly in India: clinical Profile Risk Factors and current Status of Treatment: A Hospital Based Study.

Introduction :

The incidence of cleft in India is very high (Approximately 1 in 700 life births). The risk factors for causations are not yet very clear. The treatment is also not rationalized and individual surgeons based. Hence, a study is required to determined the risk factors and the valid problems associated with clefts. Also to determined ways to improve the quality of life of these patients.

Rationale:

A population based multicenteric trial is in progress after a similar pilot study has been done to justifying the need for further larger studies.

Achievements/ Result

The cases document under the Multicentric Indicleft Project at Post Graduate Department of Plastic Surgery, K. G. Medical University, Lucknow, comprised of a sample of 252 patients

- i. There were 51 males (43 %) and 68 females (57%) constituted the age group of 10-14 yrs , whereas 41 males(52 %) and 39 females (58%) constituted in the age group of 5-9 years, whereas 27 males (46 %) and 26 females (54 %) constituted in the age group of 0- 2 years.
- ii. The risk factors investigated in the study comprised of positive familial history, exposure to X-ray /Smoke and fever/disease and intake of drugs during 1st trimester of pregnancy.
- iii. Out of these 252 patients 197 (78%) patients have no history of fever or any other disease during 1st trimester of pregnancy. 55 (22%) patients has positive history of fever. 15 patients had Viral fever, 14 patients had typhoid fever, 9 patients Had Malarial fever, 8 patients had fever, 04 patients had Jaundice and 01 patient had suffered from Tuberculosis.
- iv. No intake of any drugs/medication was observed among in 125 cases.126 cases gave a history of taking some form of medication, 48 patients used antiemetics , 14 patients used calcium/Irons pills, 48 cases used antipyretics, 10 patients antibiotics and 06 patient anti malarial. Only 01 patient got ATT for six months during 1st trimester of pregnancy.
- v. 07 patients gave positive history of exposure to X-ray.
- vi. 08 patients indulged in tobacco chewing, 03 indulged in drug.
- vii. 59 cases (28%) had positive history of exposure to smoke during 1st trimester of pregnancy. The nature of exposure to smoke was mostly due to chulha (57 patients) followed by passive smoking (08 cases). No active smoking was found.
- viii. 12 (0.5 %)cases one parent indulged in use of intoxicants, mostly 08 were tobacco chewers and 04 cases gave history of using sleeping pills.
- ix. 4 patients enrolled at PGDPS, KGMU, Lucknow had a positive history of cleft lip and palate in their family while 248 (98 %) Cases did not have any positive familial history for cleft.
- x. Majority of the cases in the study had UCLP (109 cases) with 77 UCLP left side and 32 cases with UCLP right side. BCLP was found to be second most prevaalent in the study (51 Cases). Isolated CP (50) cases at the third most prevelant in the study and rest of as follows- CLL (12) , CLA L (12), CLR (6), CLBL (5), CLA R (3), BCLA (1), Median cleft of the lip (1), Median cleft of lip and palate (1), Bifid Uvula (1).

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- xi.** In males (Total male =119) UCLP L was most prevalent type of cleft (32 cases) followed by BCLP (25 cases), UCLP R (21 Cases), Isolated CP (21 cases), CLA L (7 cases), CLL (5 cases), CLR (5 cases), CLBL (2 cases) and 01 case is Median Cleft of lip. In females (Total female =133) UCLP L was most prevalent (43 cases), Isolated CP (29 cases), BCLP (26 cases), UCLP R (11 cases), CLL (07 cases), CLA L (5 cases), CLA R (03 cases), CLBL (3 cases), CLA BL (01 case), CLR (01 case) and Median Cleft of Lip and palate (01 case), Bifid Uvula (01 case).
- xii.** In the age group of 5 to 14 years total 199 cases documented out of which 180 patient were previously operated and 19 cases were un-operated. Majority cases (83 cases) had 2 surgeries, followed by 42 cases who had undergone 3 surgeries, 32 cases with 1 surgery, 15 cases with 4 surgeries, 4 cases had history of 5 surgeries, 2 cases had undergone 6 surgeries and 2cases had undergone 7 surgeries.
- xiii.** In the age group 5 to 14 yrs total 199 cases documented out of which majority 136 cases were operated for Cleft of lip and Palate, 26 cases operated for the cleft of the palate alone, 12 cases were operated for Cleft of the lip alone, 6 cases were operated for the cleft of the lip and alveolus. 19 cases were unoperated.
- xiv.** In the age group of 5 to 14 yrs, total 136 cases operated for cleft of the lip and palate and 26 cases operated for isolated cleft palate hence total number of operated cleft palate are equals to 162. Out of 136 operated cleft palate , only 40 cases got palatal fistula.
- xv.** In the age group of 5 to 14 yrs Out of the 162 operated palate, 40 cases have palatal fistula . Out of 40 Palatal Fistula only 16 cases had speech abnormality due to fistula while 20 cases had no speech abnormality due to fistula, while 04 cases could not be assessed of speech abnormality due to fistula.
- xvi.** The breakup of 40 cases with palatal fistula was 21 cases were postalveolar, 07 cases were alveolar, 06 cases were pre alveolar and 04 cases of hard palate fistula and 02 cases were fistula of the soft palate.
- xvii.** In the age group of 5-14 yrs 199 cases documented, 40 cases had history of Past Dental Treatment and remaining 159 cases did not get any dental treatment in the past.
- xviii.** The Goslon index was obtained from the dental study models of UCLP age group 9 to 14 years based on anteroposterial dental arch relations and grouped into categories 1 to 5 based on the orthodontic treatment needs. Out of total 61 cases, 28 cases (45%) had a score of 1-2, remaining 33 cases (55%) having score 3-5, needs significant orthodontic

management. In the age group of 5 to 9 years UCLP cases were total 30, The 5 yrs old index suggested 14 cases (46%) having score 1-2, remaining 13 cases (54%) with score 3-5 needs significant orthodontic treatment

- xix.** Out of documented 199 cases 11 cases got frank nasal discharge while 188 cases had no any nasal discharge. Out of 199 cases, 12 cases complaint of frank nasal regurgitation while 19 Cases had minimal nasal regurgitation, while 168 cases had no nasal regurgitation.
- xx.** ENT assessment was done for the right and left ear in all the cases enrolled in project in the age group of 5 to 14 years. Ear discharge as function of the type of the cleft was less prevalence. It was present in 37 ears out of 396 ears, as two ears cannot assess due to presence of microtia.
- xxi.** Out of 396 tympanic membrane 304 tympanic membrane were normal, 26 tympanic membrane were perforated, 66 tympanic membrane were retracted, as two tympanic membrane cannot assess due to presence of microtia.
- xxii.** Hearing assessment was done by using audiometry out of 398 ears only 60 ears had conductive hearing loss, 338 ears had hearing sensitivity within normal limit.
- xxiii.** In documented 199 cases 51 cases had no nasalance, while 74 cases had mild nasalance , 52 cases had moderate nasalance , 22 cases had severe nasalance.
- xxiv.** In documented 199 cases 80 cases had Adequate velopharyngeal closure while 119 cases had Inadequate velopharyngeal closure during phonation. Inadequate closure maximum present in UCLP (51 cases) followed by BCLP (30 cases) and CP (25 cases).
- xxv.** In 199 documented 46 cases had Speech Articulation within normal limit, remaining 153 cases has Misarticulation of speech. It was highest in UCLP (67 cases) followed by BCLP (40 cases) and CP (30 cases).
- xxvi.** In documented 199 cases , there were 74 cases had Intelligible Speech while 90 cases had Partial Intelligible speech, remaining 35 cases had Unintelligible speech.
- xxvii.** In documented 199 cases only 03 case had stammering on speech.
- xxviii.** Out of 199 cases , 04 cases had family history of cleft, in which 01 case had father and 02 cases had mother, 01 case had sibling history of cleft. out of 04 genetic cases three families were selected for genetic study and blood sample of all members of 03 selected family were sent to main centre.

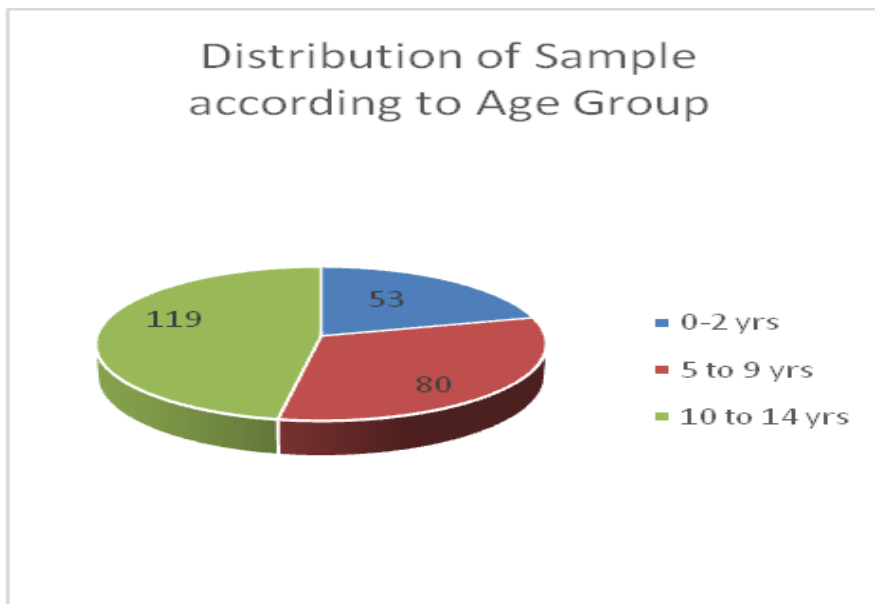

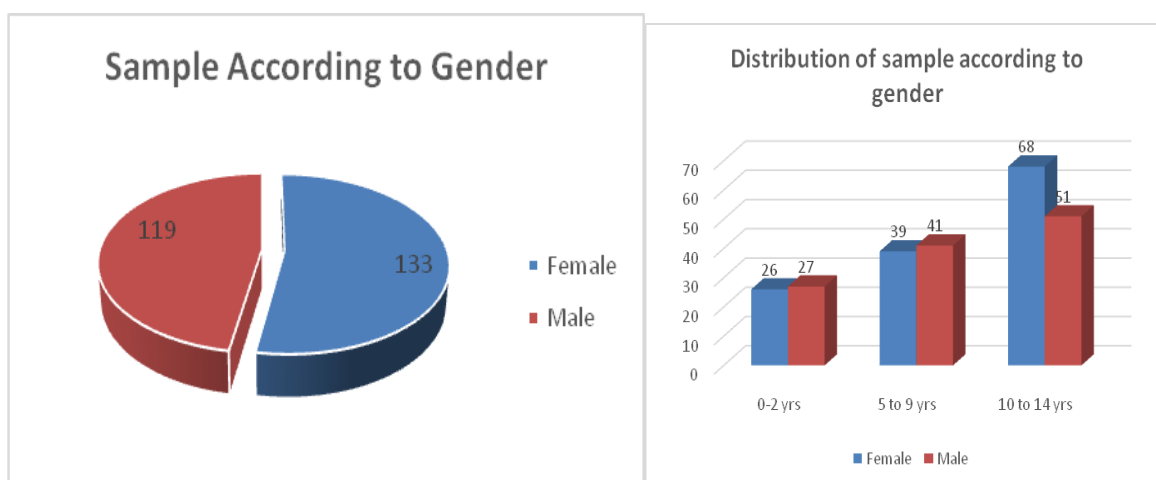
1. Distribution of Sample according to age group

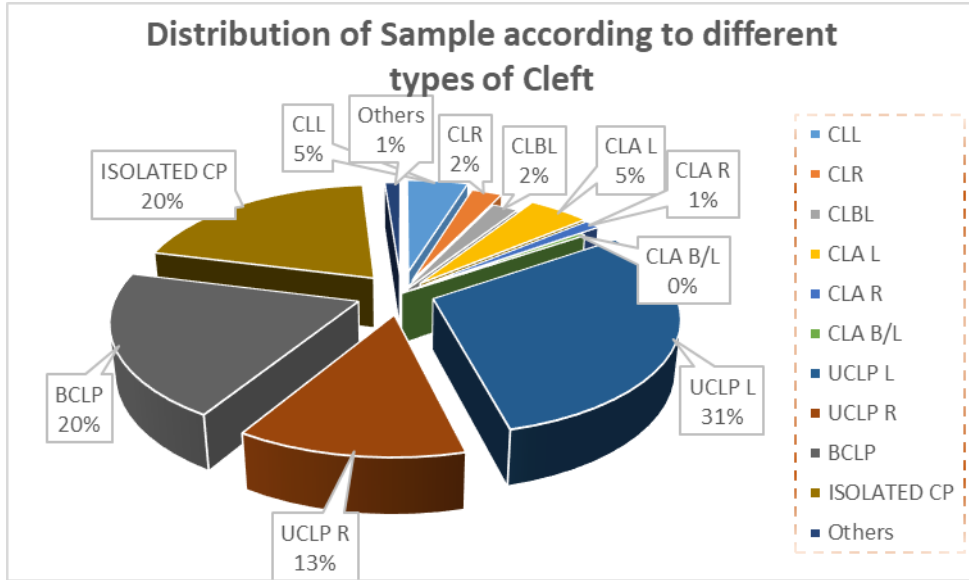
2. Distribution of sample according to gender

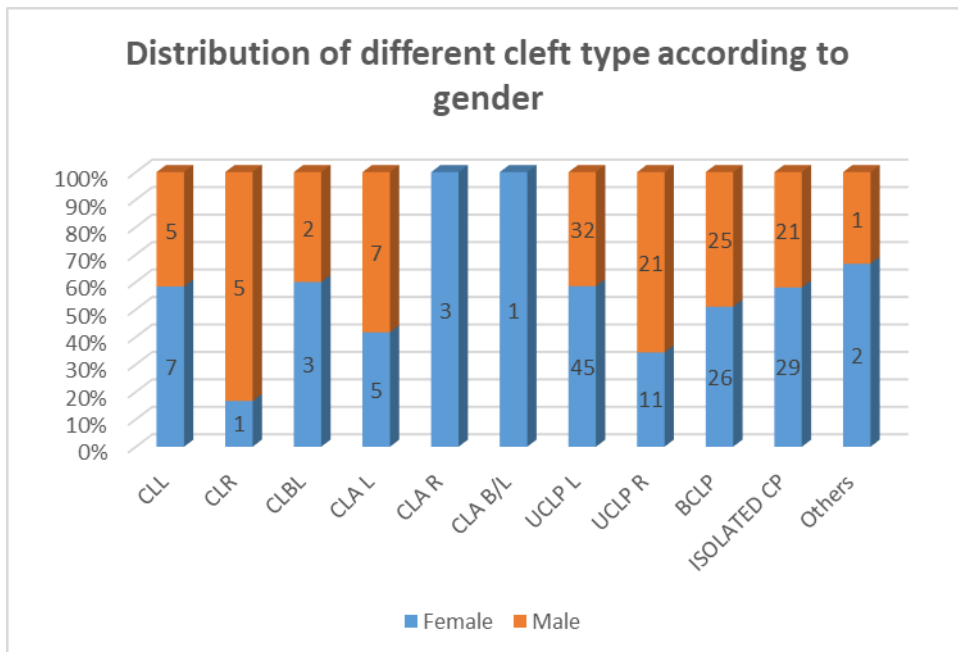
3. Distribution of sample according to different types of cleft

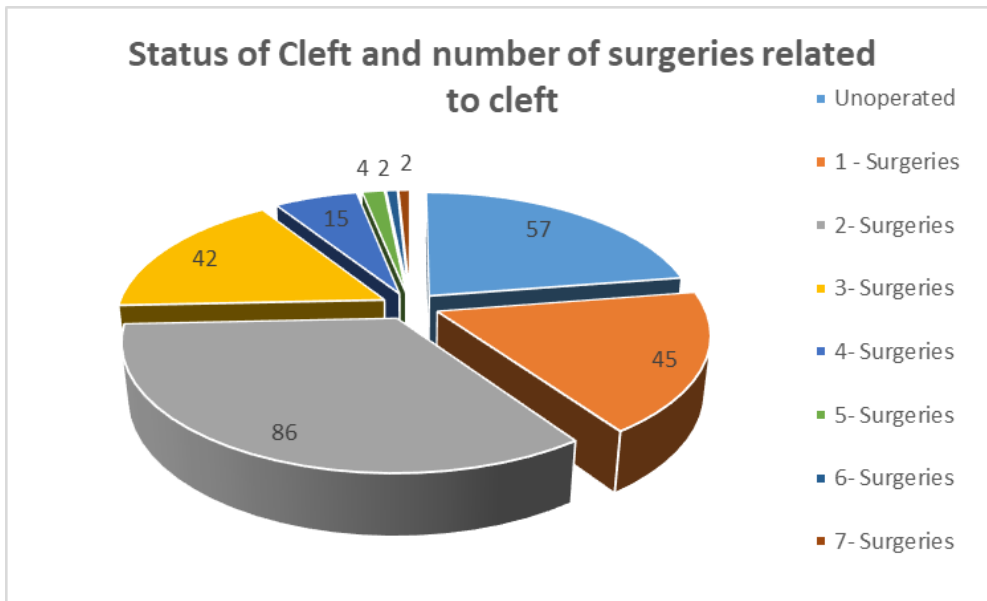
Distribution of different cleft type according to gender

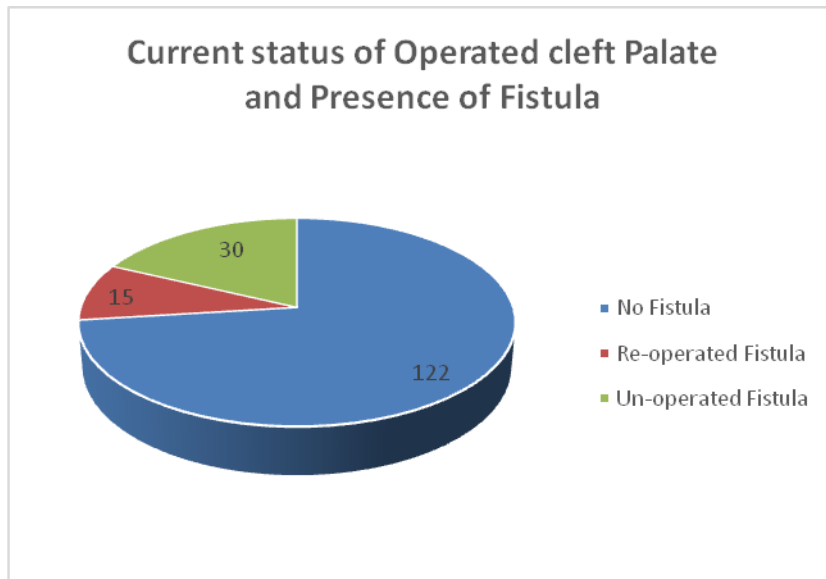
Current status of cleft and number of surgery related to cleft

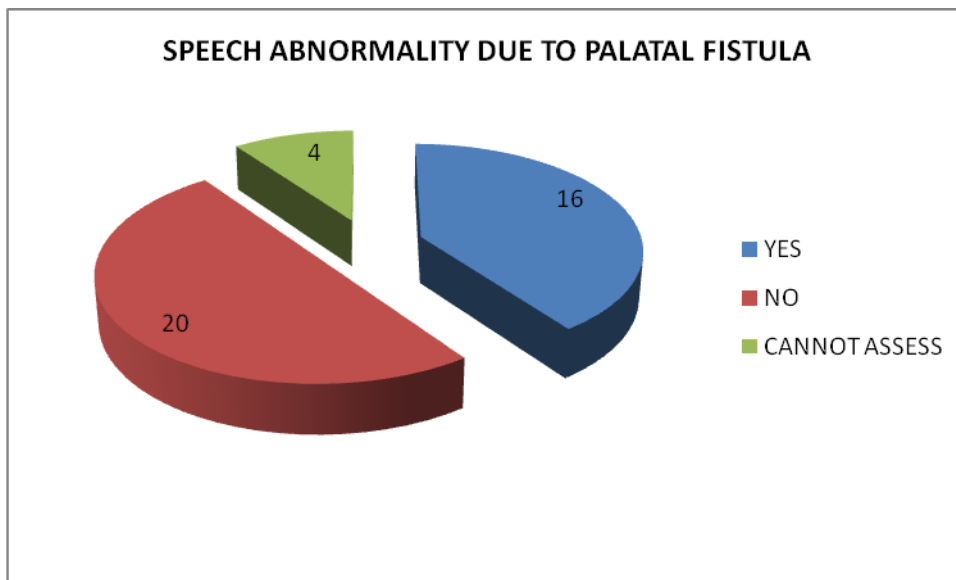

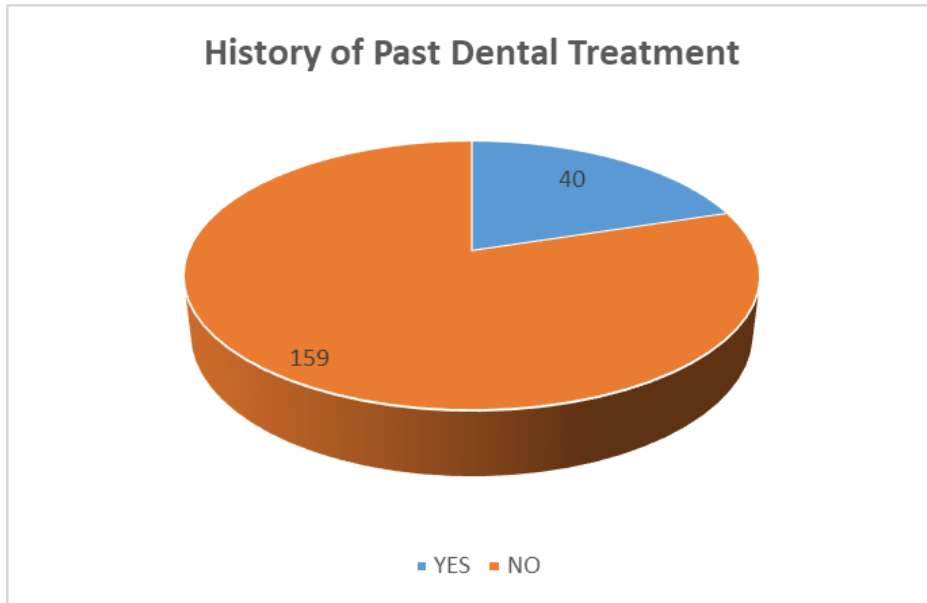

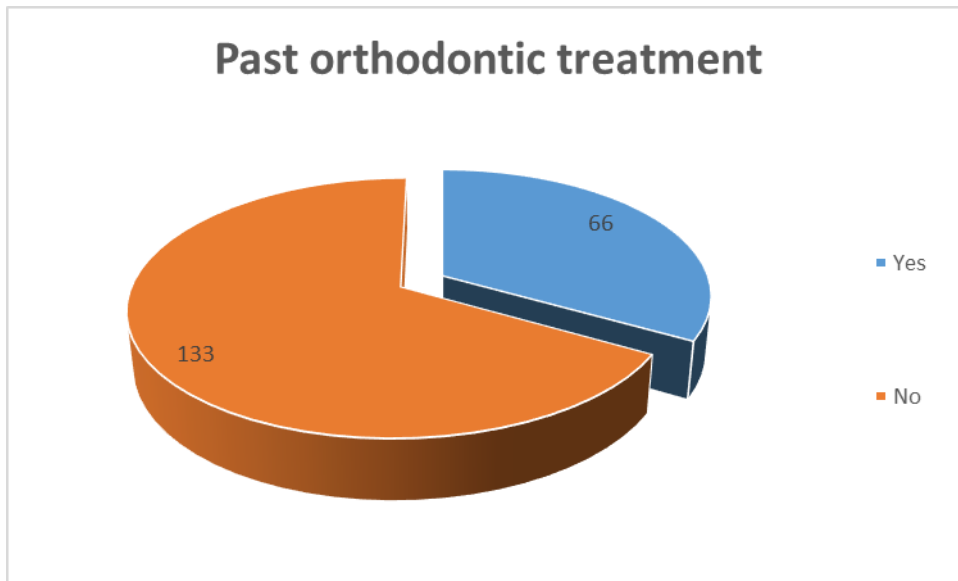
History of past dental treatment

Past orthodontic treatment

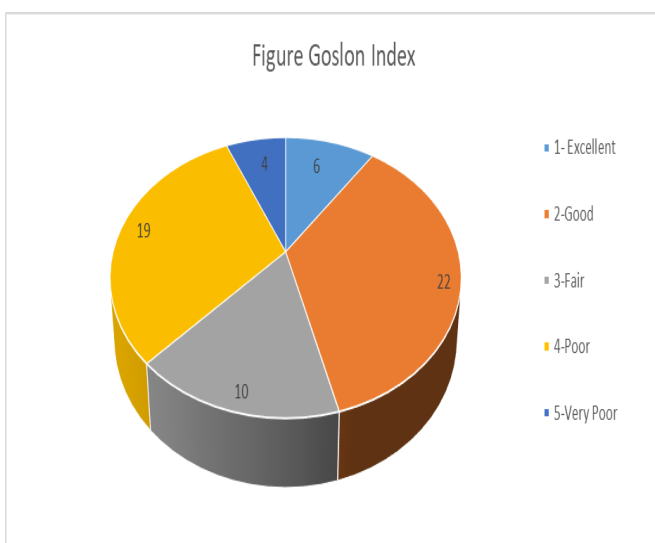

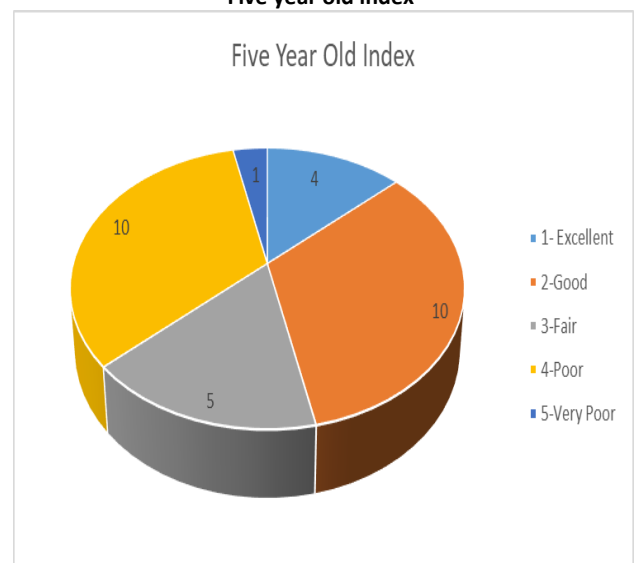
Goslon Index and five year old index

Figure Goslon Index

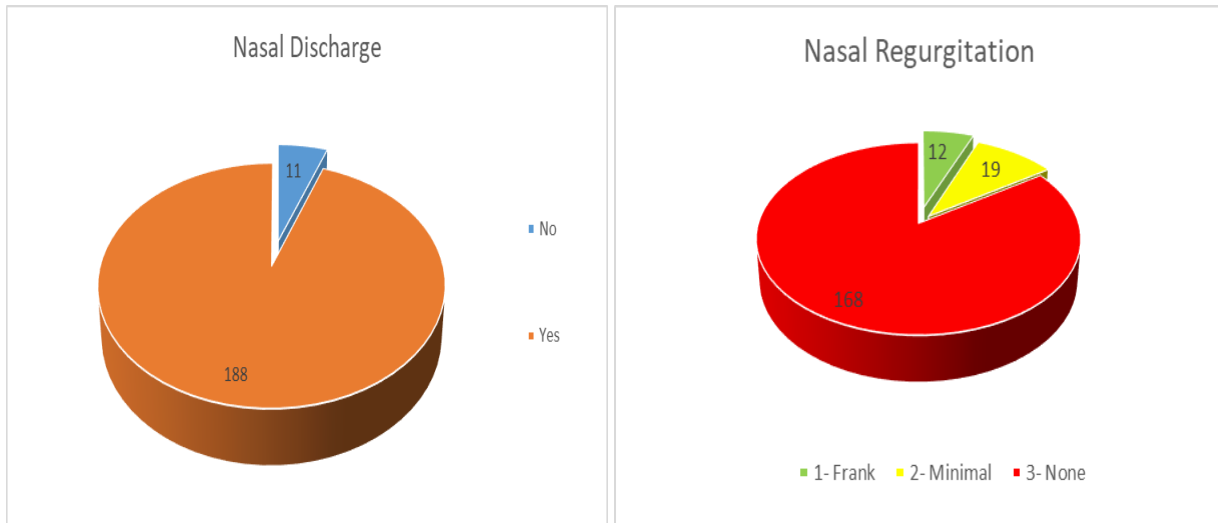


Five year old index

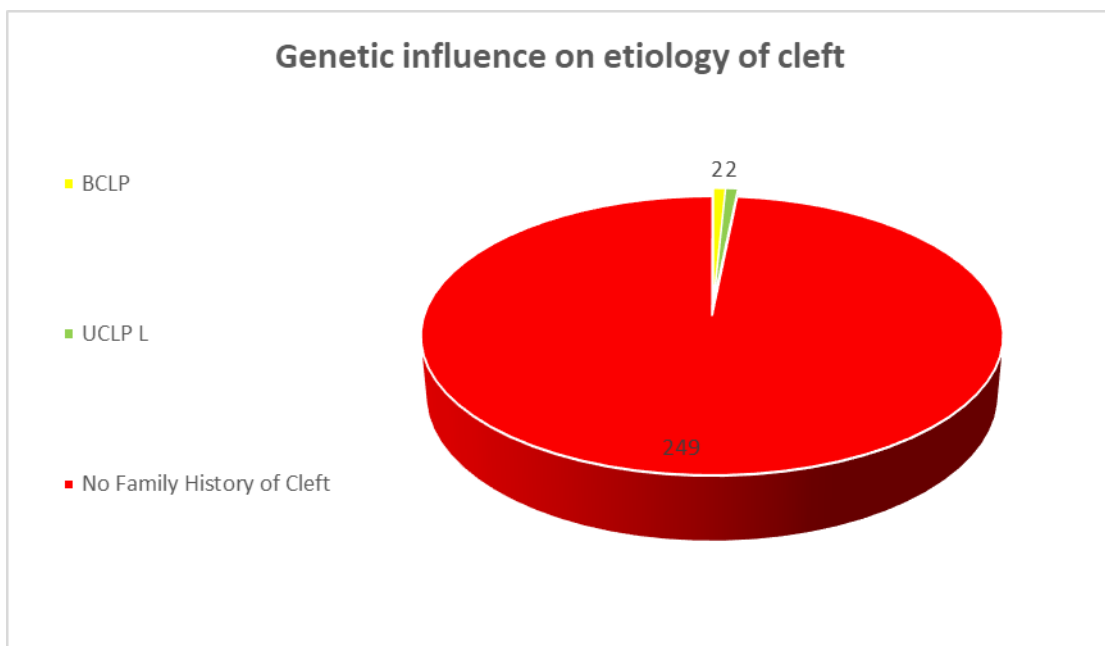

The Director-General of the Indian Council of Medical Research sanctions an allotment for **Rs.12,15,070/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh Fifteen Thousand Seventy Only)** as detailed in the attached budget statement for the above mentioned project for the year 15/07/2021 to 14/07/2022 during the year 2021-22 subject to the following conditions:
