The body donation program paced up in the year 2001 with the help of "Gayatri Parivaar", when Dr. Ashok Sahai along with other colleagues of the department started taking lectures for the awareness of body donation in the nearby rural & urban areas. Since then, many people of different caste & creed have been coming to the department for filling the body donation forms and getting their bodies registered for donation to the Department of Anatomy, KGMU UP for teaching, learning and research purposes.

The form is filled in duplicate and is signed by the spouse or children (near & dear ones) so that at the time of death, the body can be donated to the medical college without any problems.

The body donation form is available on the official KGMU website.

From the year 2017 to 2021, total 621 bodies are registered for donation.

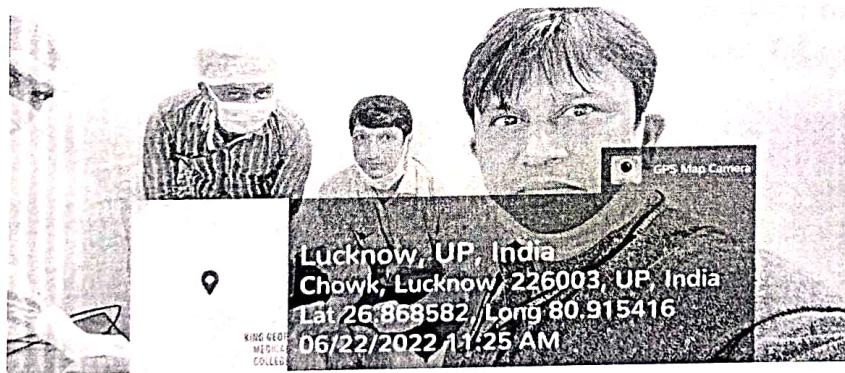
