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### Core committee meeting of IQAC 07<sup>th</sup> November 2020

An IQAC core committee meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Honourable Vice Chancellor, King George's Medical University, Lucknow on 07<sup>th</sup> November 2020 at Board room, Administrative Block, KGMU, Lko., Dean Medicine, Prof. Vinita Das, Dean Dental- Prof. Shadab Mohammad, Dean Paramedical- Prof. Vinod Jain, Vice Dean QP Dr. Richa Khanna-to discuss and apprise about the future plans to be implemented for the coming academic year. Prof. Divya Mehrotra, Dean Quality and Planning recommended following measures to be taken by the respective university authorities to improve the quality of university procedures.

As the knowledge is expanding and our university has good resource material in the form of trained faculty and good number of patients from all over the state and also from neighbouring states, it is high time that we initiate new courses for building nations capacity in special care. Authorities must promote and facilitate development of proposals of postgraduate, super speciality, fellowship and postdoctoral courses.

To enhance the use of digital platforms in Teaching and Learning processes: A digital library of resource material has to be developed for each module and should be available to the students. It is need of hour to develop a central facility for dissemination of tele lectures.

To Strengthen the teachers training in Medical Education Technology: In addition to Basic course in Medical Education Technologies, faculty must be motivated to join various workshops, seminars in this field.

To promote innovation: It is expected from Innovation cell to promote the process of patent filing by faculty and visible outcome during the coming years.

To promote research participation among undergraduate students: It is often seen that generally undergraduate students do not participate in research activities. Students must be made aware of various research grants like from ICMR STS etc, and should be encouraged to apply for intramural as well extramural research projects.

**Strengthening the Infrastructure:** As most of the buildings in our campus are approx. 100 years old and require renovation to meet the current standards, It is recommended to survey and assess the need of repair and maintenance by experts. It is also recommended that civil department should make a priority list and a separate budget must be dedicated for repair and maintenance.

**Expanding wings:** As the campus is placed in a central location of the city within 100 mts of buildings of historical reputes, horizontal and vertical extension is not possible due to restrictions of ASI (Archaeological Survey of India), appropriate plan has to be built for expansion of hospital facilities. The planning to develop a Satellite centre for providing Patient care services must be materialized as early as possible.

**To enhance students' participation in extracurricular activities:** In medical institutes it is often seen that technical training is always kept on priority. Students feel overburdened with studies and find less time for recreational activities. Though certain departments are constantly conducting certain programmes but a systematic involvement in extracurricular programmes is not followed. So, the respective deans must take appropriate planning for coming batches. It is also expected to plan such activities well in advance and the same must be reflected in the academic calendar.

**Planned to successfully implement various Government Schemes :** In lack of training of employees a constant feedback from patients was noted that they are not able to get benefits of various schemes. Proper instructions to faculty and training of employees should be done.

**To develop quality sensitization among various departments:** Departmental Ranking must be done to sensitize departments about various quality benchmarks in education, research, administration etc.

**To Enhance social outreach and Community Services of university:** All departments must conduct certain awareness programmes for nearby localities. These programmes must involve undergraduate and post graduate students to build better understanding of societal needs and also their role in prevention activities.

**To create unique state of art facilities in patient care:** The university should grab the opportunities of unique nature to provide new facilities in patient care.

**E Governance :** it is mandatory that digital platforms should be used strategically to improve management in all sectors.

**Employees Welfare Measures:** Employees raised issues of security. Authorities must take appropriate measures to protect rights of doctors as well as employees.
