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## MINUTES OF MEETING

01/02/2020

A meeting with all undergraduate and post graduate students was organised on 01 February, 2020, to discuss their problems on issues of Teaching -learning, hostels, faculty support, research training, feedback current plans and invite suggestions for future plans of IQAC, King George's Medical University.

The following points were raised by the students:


- Communication gap in receiving the clear structured curriculum of their educational program. Though they accepted that it was available on the websites of regulatory bodies.
- Students wanted more interaction with senior faculty, one to one clinical discussions and more interactive teaching learning activities
- Postgraduate students were more concerned about the distribution of workload between residents and permanent/contractual employees. They requested for a prior delegation of work and compliance to be assured.
- Students raised the need for a more efficient referral system amongst the busy clinical departments of the University.
- Library was a concern in terms of privacy, space, availability of books, and e-subscription delays.
- Students wanted the teaching sessions to have reflection component at the end for their better understanding of the content.
- Hostels infrastructure maintenance was the point raised by most of the students in terms of annual transfers, mess facilities, electrical fixtures, water supply, need for repair, washroom amenities, Wifi speed and facility.
- Some students also voiced for safety in the campus
- Students expressed their concern for lack of time for research due to clinical overload in some departments
- Availability of hardware like printers was reported for some IPD setups.
