The department of Ophthalmology KGMU is organizing 6<sup>th</sup> Annual conference of “Association of Community Ophthalmologists of India” (ACOIN) 2015 to be held at Convention Centre, King George’s Medical University, Lucknow from 30<sup>th</sup> of Oct, 2015 to 1<sup>st</sup> of Nov. 2015. This organization is instituted with the aim of building a global platform for exchange of ongoing ideas and subsequent implementation in ophthalmic practice with an intention of improving the eye health of community, and improving training of the eye care professionals at all levels, particularly those involved in eye care services in the peripheral areas.
