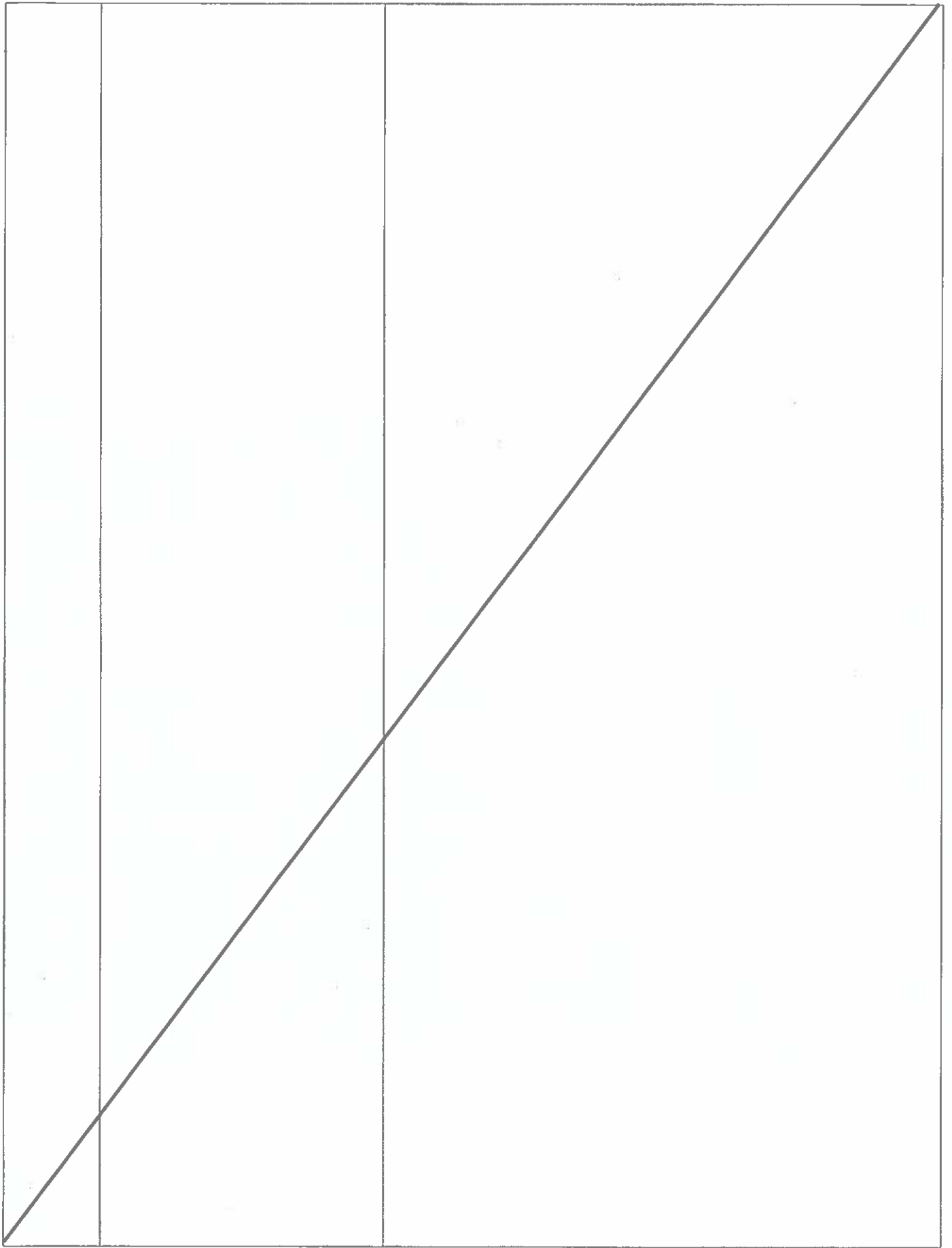

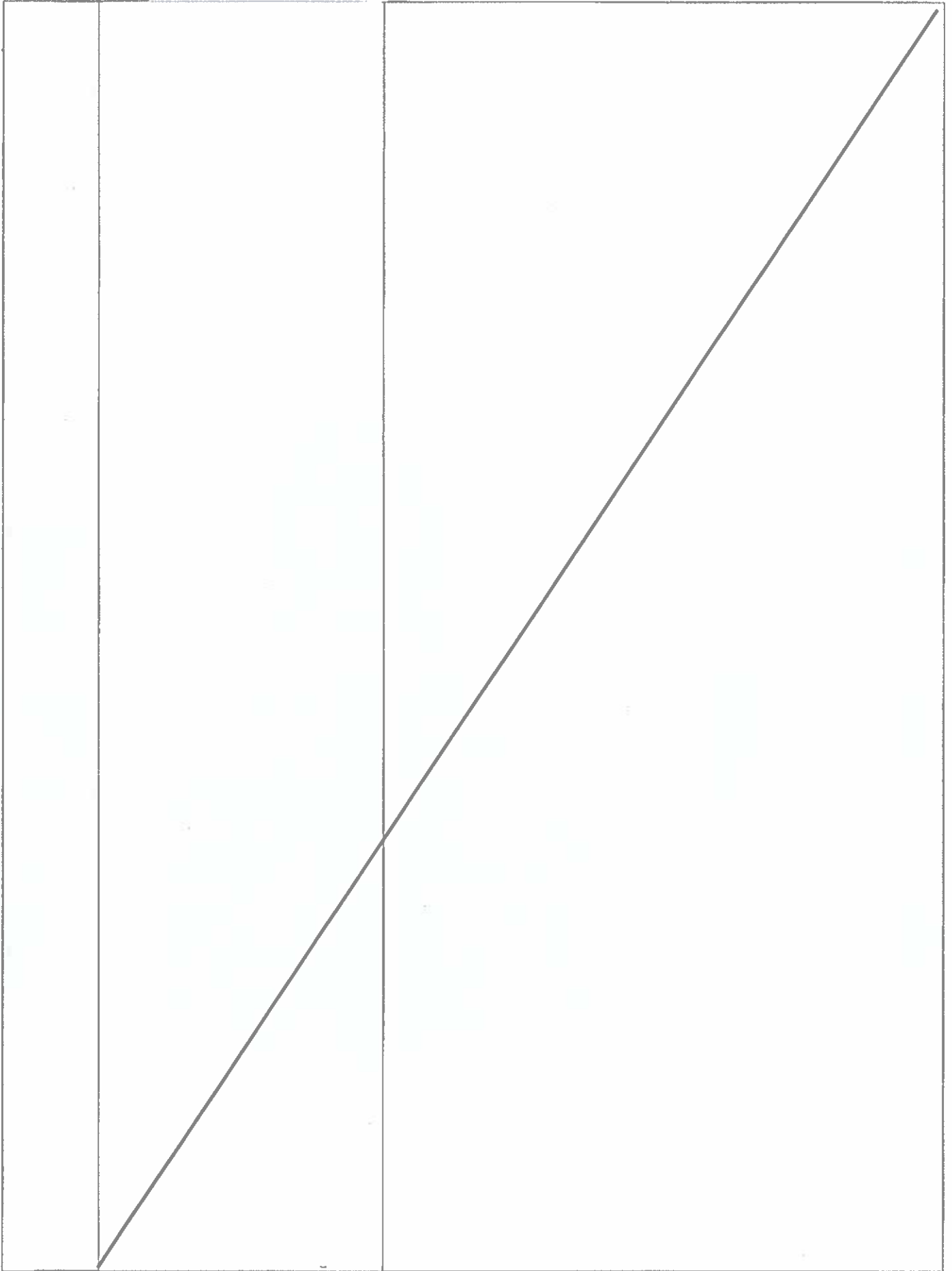

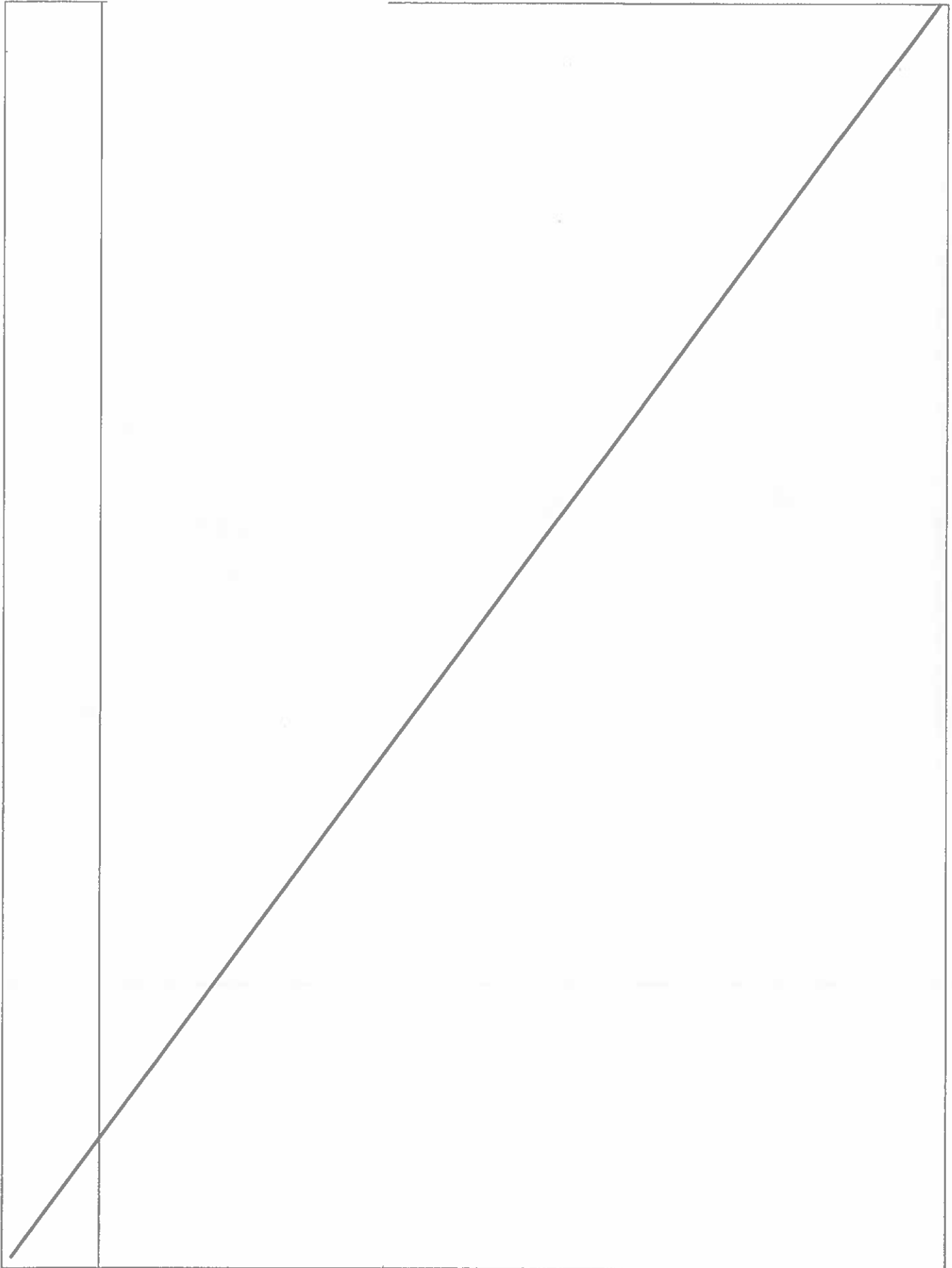

4.	<b>Compliance with the Hon'ble High Court Order dated 28.11.2024 issued in Writ Petition No. 11308 of 2024 : Dr. Madhuban Tiwari versus King George's Medical University through Registrar &amp; Others</b>	<p>The Executive Council noted the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- In pursuance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 18-02-2020, a Review Committee was set up on 12-3-2020. The Executive Council accepted the recommendations of the said Review Committee in its meeting held on 27-06-2020 and the University administration also complied on the recommendations of the said Review Committee.</li> <li>2- Thereafter, Dr Madhuban Tiwari represented against the compliance by the University administration on the recommendations of the above stated review committee.</li> <li>3- On the representation of Dr. Madhuban Tiwari, again a Review Committee was constituted by University Administration which submitted its report on 27.03.2023.</li> <li>4- Dr Madhuban Tiwari filed a writ petition No 11308 of 2024 in the Hon'ble High Court for the implementation of the report dated 27.03.2023 of the Review Committee.</li> <li>5- Hon'ble High Court passed the following order on the above writ petition on 28-11-2024 : <i>"Considering the aforesaid and the report dated 27-07-2023 already having been submitted, let a decision be taken by the competent authority, said to be the Executive Council, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Disposed of. for any changes to the departmental inter-se seniority of the Department of Medicine and the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery, as issued via Office Circular No-82/B-2022, dated 16 July 2022.

2. After a thorough examination of the representation submitted through the Office of the Hon'ble Chancellor, it is evident that the claims raised by the complainant lack merit when assessed in view of the applicable statutory provisions and judicial precedents.
3. The selection process undertaken by King George's Medical University (KGMU) has adhered to the **Uttar Pradesh Government Servants Seniority Rules, 1991**, and relevant **KGMU statutes**.
4. The allegations regarding prioritization of backlog recruitments for seniority, purported violations of statutes, and non-compliance with government orders have been addressed in detail. They have been found inconsistent with the established legal framework. As such, the claims presented in the representation do not substantiate any deviation from prescribed norms or any infringement of the complainant's rights.

*The Executive Council was in agreement with the recommendations of the above review committee and approved the same.*

*The Executive Council further directed that the recommendations of the review committee and the decision of the Executive Council be placed before the Hon'ble Chancellor for her kind consideration.*

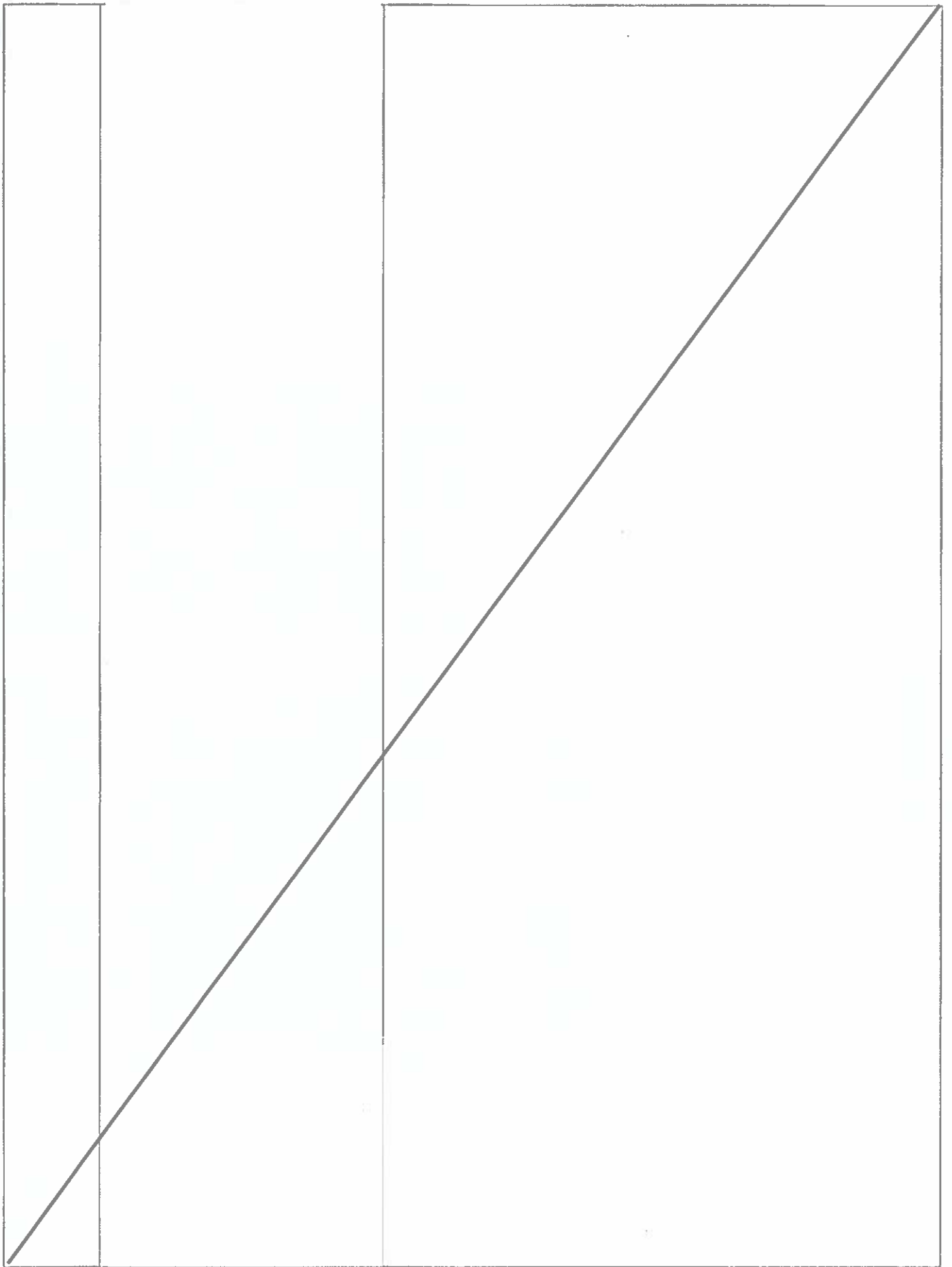

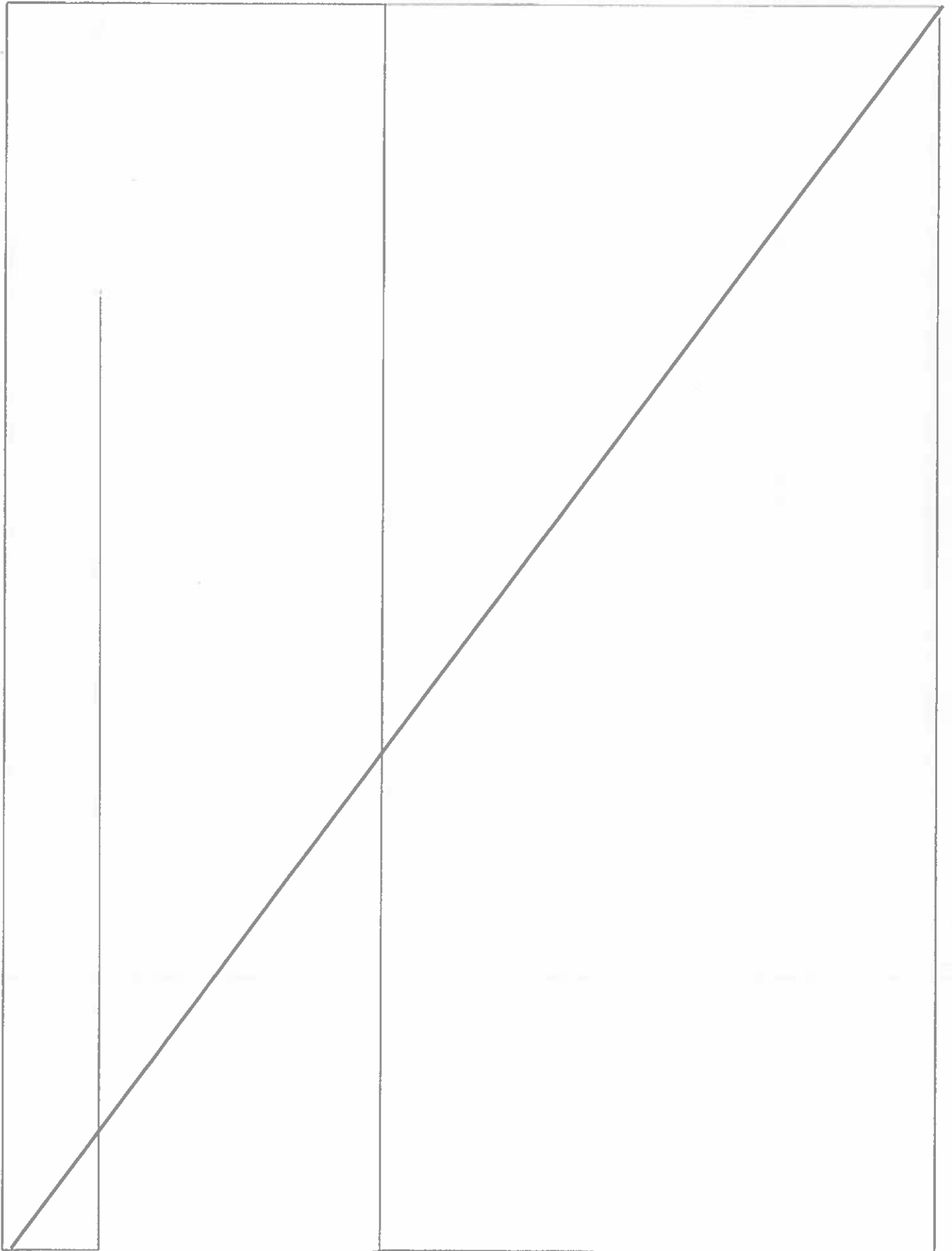

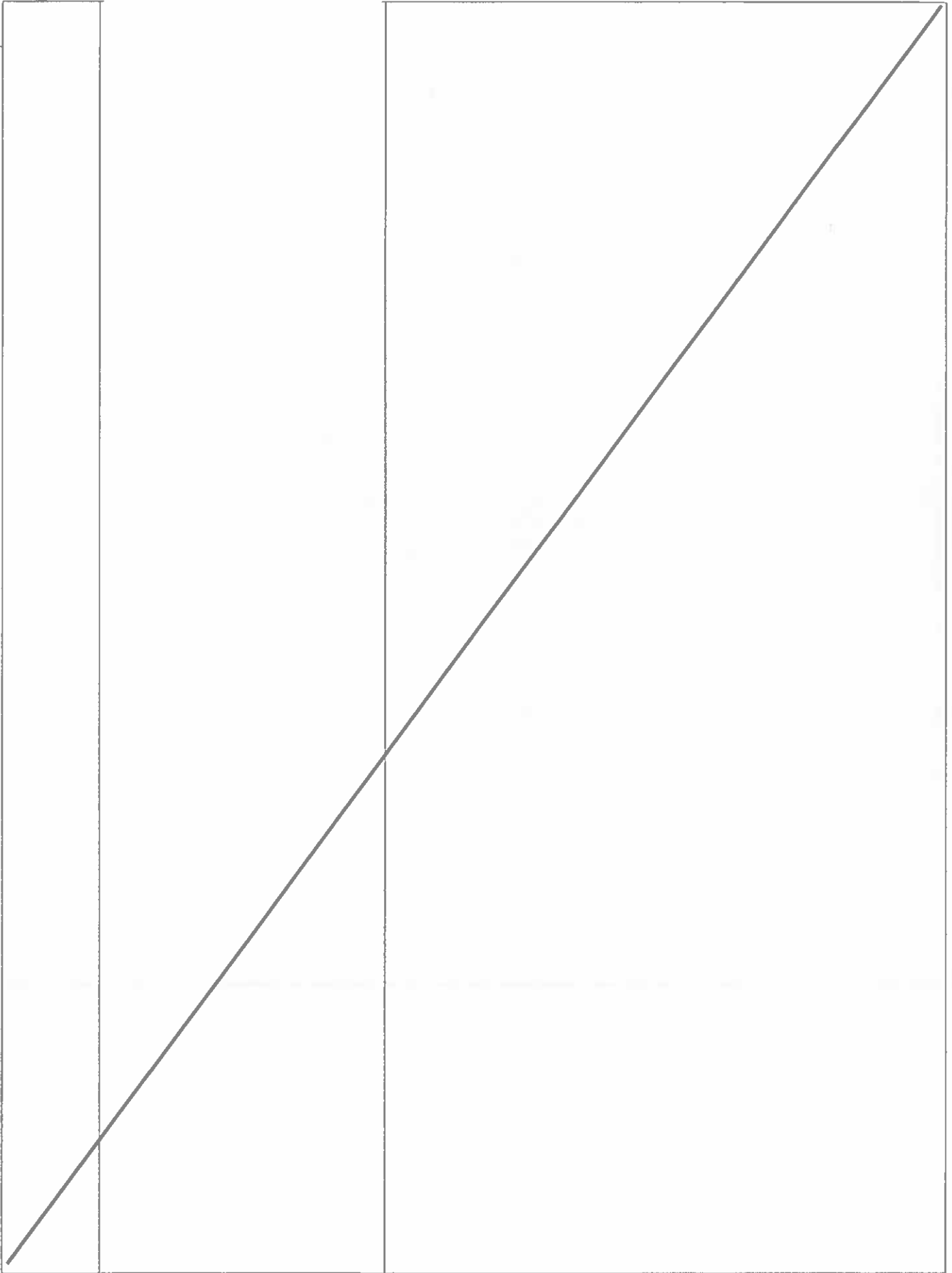
