Academic SOP for B.Sc. Nursing Semester Programme

(As per INC Gazette dated 5th July 2021 and Corrigendum dated 8th April 2022)

1. **ATTENDANCE:**

- a) Attendance will be counted as per the joining of the students, with the commencement of classes. However, all students should complete theory-80% and clinical 100% to complete the course as per INC rules after 8th Semester.
- b) Students have to join the college as per the admission guideline issued by the institution. Second and third counselling students have to join immediately after admission and their attendance will be counted from the day of their admission.
- c) Theory and Clinical attendance will be taken separately for each Semester.

2. **ELIGIBILITY FOR UNIVERSITY EXAM:**

2.1 Attendance-

- a) Students must have 80% attendance in theory as well as in practical to be eligible for appearing in University Examination.
- b) Those students whose attendance falls below 80% can complete their attendance by doing *compensation during vacation and preparatory leaves*. After those compensation if the students fulfils the required attendance he/she will be eligible to appear for the University Examination.
- c) *Even after doing compensation during vacation and Preparatory Leave, if he/she has deficit attendance they will not be allow to appear for University Examination. However he/she may continue doing compensation to complete 80% attendance.*

2.2. Internal Assessment (IA) marks-

- a) Students must have secure 50% in Internal Assessment from total given Internal marks for each subject in Theory & Practical to be eligible for appearing for University Examination.
- b) However minimum pass marks shall be 40% for Communicative English.
- c) *Those students who fail in Internal assessment, one remedial exam will be conducted for eligibility. If still he/she fails after remedial exam, they will give exam with the next upcoming Semester including internal and University Examination.*

2.3. Examination Criteria-

- a) *Students shall cleared in all the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th Semester Examinations before appearing for the 5th Semester University Examination.*
- b) *Students shall have cleared all the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th Semester Examination before appearing for 7th Semester Examination.*
- c) *The candidate shall have cleared all the previous Examinations before appearing final year (8th Semester) Examination.*
- d) *However, the student can appear for the forthcoming Semester Examination only after appearing the previous Semester Examination.*
e.g.- Students can appear for 2nd Semester Examination only after appearing for 1st Semester Examination & so on.

3. **MANDATORY MODULE AND ELECTIVE MODULE:**

3.1. Elective Module-

- a) Students should complete 3 Elective modules on the topics mentioned in the syllabus.

- b) *First in 3rd Semester, 2nd in 5th Semester and third in 7th Semester compulsory as specified in University Examination.*
- c) The Elective Module should be planned in such a way that it should complete the stipulated hours in one slot.
- d) *In extreme exceptional cases if the students is not able to complete the Elective Module in planned schedule then he/she may be allowed to complete in the vacation and preparatory leave with the permission of Dean Nursing*
- e) Minimum pass marks for Elective Module shall be 40% to appear for the specified Semester University Examination.

3.2. Mandatory Module-

- a) The Mandatory modules should be planned in such a way that it should complete the stipulated hours in one slot.
- b) The students have to pass in all Mandatory modules placed within the course and pass marks for each module is 50%.
- c) The allotted percentage of marks will be included in the Internal Assessment of University Examination
- d) **Mandatory modules will be considered as value added course for the B.Sc. Nursing Course.**

4. PRACTICAL EXAMINERS:

- a) Maximum number of candidates for practical Examination should not exceed 20 per day, particular year and of same institution batch shall be examined by the same set of examiners.
- b) *To fulfil the mentioned criteria, KGMU College of Nursing will have two sets of examiners (Two Internal & Two External Examiners) to complete the practical exam.*

5. RESEARCH PROJECT:

- a) The student shall do mandatory small research group project in 7th Semester itself.
- b) *The Tutor who is having M.Sc. Nursing with three years teaching experience will be guide for the B.Sc. Nursing course.*

Note- Apart from this above guidelines, all of the above guidelines mentioned in the INC Gazette dated 5th July 2021 & the corrigendum dated 8th April 2022 will be strictly followed.

Academic SOP for M.Sc. Nursing Course

1. GENERAL ATTENDANCE: As per INC guidelines

- a) Attendance will be counted as per the joining of the students, with the commencement of classes.
- b) Students have to join the college as per the admission guideline issued by the institution. Second and third counselling students have to join immediately after admission and their attendance will be counted from the day of their admission.
- c) Theory and Clinical attendance will be taken separately for each subject.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR UNIVERSITY EXAM: As per INC Gazette

2.1 Attendance-

- a) Students must have 80% attendance in theory as well as in practical to be eligible and for appearing for University Examination.
- b) Those students whose attendance falls below 80% can complete their attendance by doing compensation during vacation and Preparatory leaves. If after those compensation the students fulfils the required attendance he/she will be eligible to appear for the University Examination.
- c) If he/she still does not complete the deficit attendance, he will not be allowed to sit for University Examination, but he/she may continue doing compensation duty during the days of university Examination to complete 80% attendance.

2.2. Internal Assessment (IA) marks-

- a) Students must have secure 50% in Internal Assessment from total given Internal marks for each subject in Theory & Practical to be eligible for appearing for University Examination.
- b) Those students who fail in Internal assessment, one remedial exam will be conducted to attain eligibility. If still student fails after remedial exam, then student have to give exam with the next upcoming Supplementary Examination.

3. THESIS Co-GUIDE:

Tutors having 3 years of PG teaching experience after M.Sc. Nursing Degree may be considered as Co- guide in that subject.

The Course was co-ordinated by Mrs. Anugrah Charan (B.Sc. Nursing 5th Semester Co-ordinator).

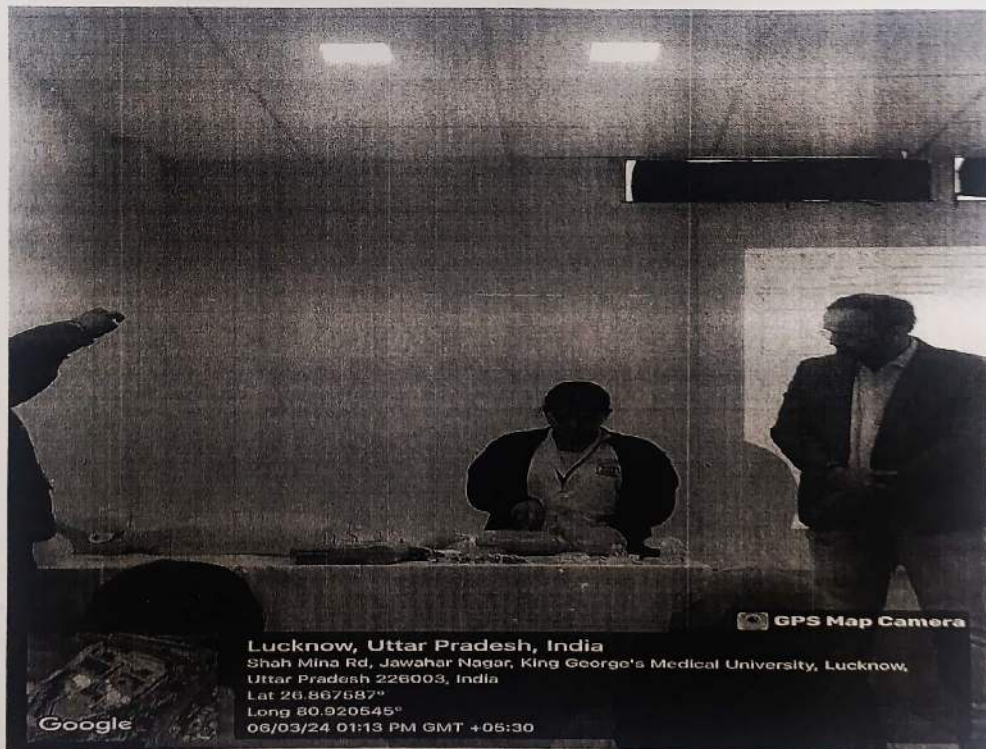
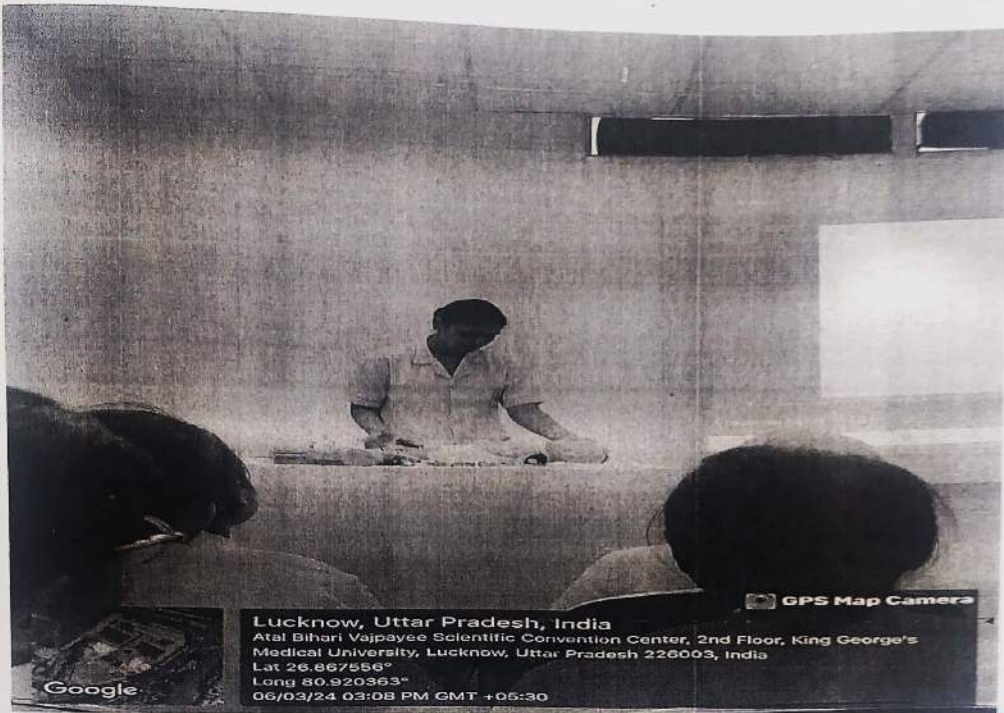
