## ACTION TAKEN REPORT FOR FEEDBACK TAKEN DURING JULY 2023-JUNE 2024

Dear all,

Following were the observations from the **Feedback received for the period of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023- 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024** from various stakeholders of university like teachers, students, examiners and alumni. You all are requested to keep this feedback in mind & implement the remedial measures.

1. As per **teacher's perception of curriculum**, it was suggested that
  - a. In Dental department, curriculum needs to be updated to align international teaching standards
  - b. Revision of curriculum needs to include artificial intelligence
  - c. Evening classes for students of MBBS should be restarted
  - d. The curriculum and teaching need to focus more on "must know" areas rather than "may now"
  - e. All the changes in curriculum and amendments in curriculum needs to be shared with all faculty members either via email or common platforms like Whatsapp groups

### **Action taken:**

- i. Curriculum has defined "must know" areas in each subject and discipline and it is stressed that same must be complied
- ii. Artificial intelligence has been included in subject wise curriculum especially radio-diagnosis, neurology, Neurosurgery etc
- iii. The changes in curriculum are passed through Board of Studies & to be shared by email with all HODs

### **2. The feedback analysis of examiners suggested**

- a. Supplementary examination of students should be conducted after a gap of 3 months
- b. Pattern of examination was good and satisfactory
- c. KGMU should enter into a contract with hotels for stay of examiners
- d. Copy checking and practical examination should be done by different examiners

### **Action taken :**

- i. The points were noted and will be taken up in appropriate forum

### **3. As per the feedback analysis of alumni, it was suggested**

- a. KGMU is an excellent and great institute
- b. There should be increase in faculty recruitment to improve teacher-student ratio
- c. Increased measures to improve the communication between teacher and student
- d. More alumni need to be involved in planned CME and felicitation programs
- e. There were suggestions to reduce the patient load in OPD
- f. There were also suggestions to improve hostel facility

  - d. The students also wanted sessions of mental health counseling
  - e. The students wanted more entrepreneurship skill training
  - f. More interdepartmental symposium

- i. The theory and clinical classes have been scheduled as per NMC norms and all the skill-based training are conducted at skill and simulation labs
- ii. It was also informed to all faculty members to ensure mixed teaching including blackboard and power point presentation
- iii. It is also instructed to organize more interdepartmental symposium
- iv. All departments are organizing skill training with guest faculty also.

The academic committee meeting was called to review feedback on academic and other matters given by MBBS students & provided by the IQAC, KGMU. The feedback had been collected using a google form based survey. Other agenda included matters related to attendance of MBBS students and discussion of any other academic issues.


1. Feedback by MBBS students was discussed. It was found to be overall positive. The students found classes and clinics contributed positively to their growth. They were in the main satisfied with the academic ambience. One concern that several students expressed in the comments section was with the use of PowerPoint presentations in lectures. The specific points mentioned included
  - A. Too much content
  - B. Teachers were fast
  - C. Some teachers read out slides without explaining content.The committee agreed that individual departments should be informed regarding the feedback.
2. The committee suggested that departments should be asked to constitute a departmental academic committee to review PowerPoint slides that are to be used in lectures for content. Where chalk and talk is to be used, outline of lectures could be reviewed.
3. A demonstration of an app based software that would make attendance taking fast and record keeping simpler was made. The committee felt this would be useful with some built-in random re-checking mechanisms for proxies. In addition the committee felt there was a need to draw up stricter rules with fines, along with implementation of any software based system.



5. The need to compile attendance at department level on a monthly basis so that students could be warned about shortfall in time was discussed. It was felt that some software was required to make this feasible.







### **The Agenda of the meeting:**

After the meeting, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Lt. Gen. Bipin Puri sir gave his final remarks that an advisory will be issued to all the departments for maintaining proper cleanliness in the department and improving staff behavior.
