1. **Name of Examination :** Masters in Health Profession Education (MHPE) Course Entrance Examination 2023
2. **Date & Time of the Examination :** **23rd July 2023 (Sunday) at 11:00 AM to 12.30 PM**
3. **Seats available:**
 - 3.1. **A maximum of 30 (Thirty) candidates will be admitted each year.** Number of Seats may increase or decrease as per discretion of the **Hon'ble Vice Chancellor**, King George's Medical University, U.P., Lucknow.
 - 3.2. **Reservation of Seats:** The seats will be allocated as per the reservation policy of the KGMU/ Government of Uttar Pradesh.

4. Eligibility Criteria:

- 4.1. Candidate must be an Indian National.
- 4.2. Teaching faculty of Medical/Dental/Nursing/Allied Sciences. Since this is in Campus course, no leave will be required by KGMU faculty. Course is open for out campus faculty too.
- 4.3. ***MHPE Course for Internal Candidates –***

For MHPE course 15 seats are available for Faculty of Medical and Faculty of Dental Sciences of King George's Medical University, U.P., Lucknow.

 - 4.3.1. 5-Assistant Professor
 - 4.3.2. 5-Associate Professor
 - 4.3.3. 5-Additional Professor/Professor
 - 4.3.4. If total applications are more than 15, selection preference will be done as follows:-
 - a. Longest duration of service in King George's Medical University, U.P., Lucknow.
 - b. Older in age
 - c. Highest number of publications in indexed peer reviewed journals (Pubmed/Scopus)
- 4.4. ***MHPE Course for External Candidates –***
 - 4.4.1. For MHPE course 15 seats are available for external candidates.
 - 4.4.2. Entrance will be through written examination

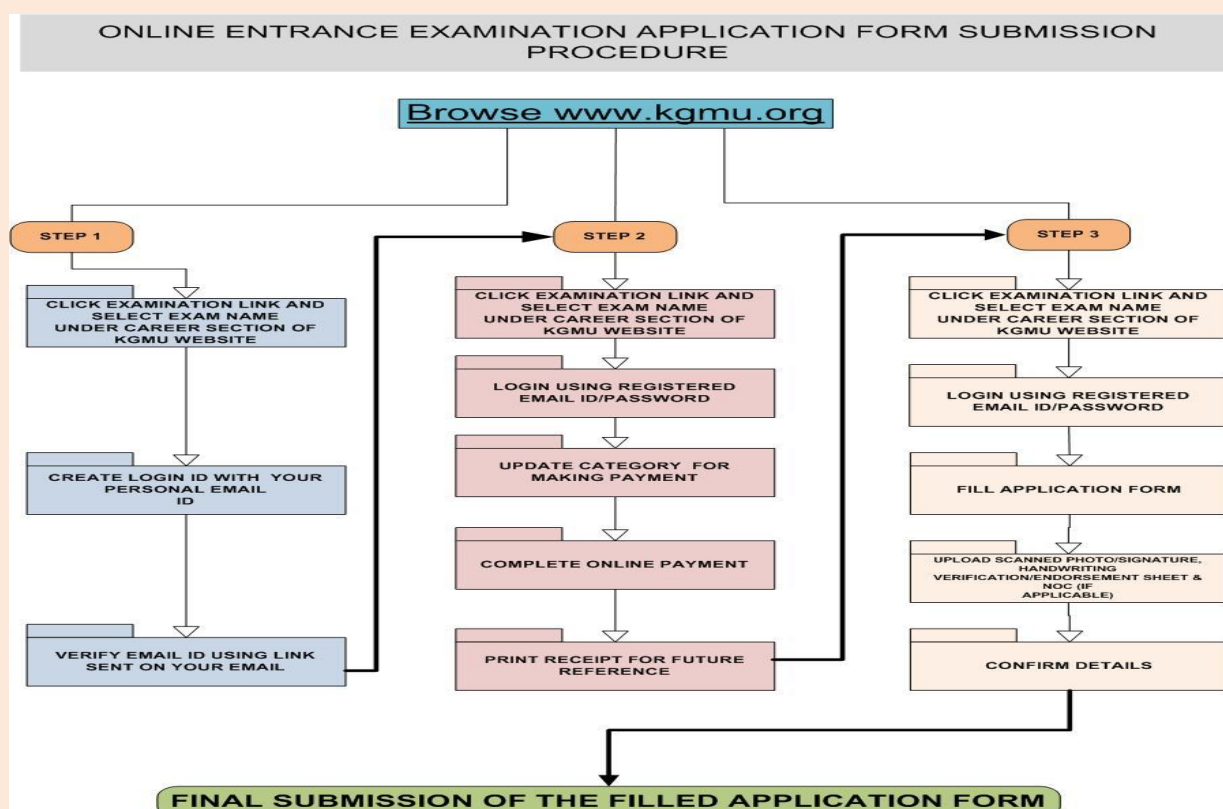
5. Application and Fees Submission for Entrance Examination:

Application for the aforesaid examinations can be done through **ONLINE MODE ONLY** via link provided on the King George's Medical University, U.P., Lucknow Official Website <https://www.kgmu.org>.

- 5.1. Candidate applicants must create their login-id using his/her registered e-mail ids & mobile number.
- 5.2. The candidate can then login into the system through OTP sent to them on their registered email ids and/or mobile number to proceed for online payment.
- 5.3. Examination fees are **INR 4000** for **Unreserved (UR) & OBC** candidates and **INR 3000** for **SC/ST** candidates.
- 5.4. Remittance of fees shall be done through **PAYMENT GATEWAY of Indian Bank** provided in the **ONLINE application. Candidates can remit the fees using debit/credit card or through internet**

- banking.** Once the remittance of fees is done then only the system will allow proceeding further and submitting the duly filled application form.
- 5.5. No application form shall be received by post.
 - 5.6. The application form completed in all respect should be Online submitted up to **15th July 2023 (Saturday)**. **Incomplete forms and the forms received after the due date will be rejected. No communication in this regard will be entertained under any circumstances.**
 - 5.7. Internal Candidates (KGMU Faculty), may submit the Application Form Online by downloading the application form after successful payment of fees. The form should be filled and duly forwarded by respective Head of Department and Dean and the scanned copy of the application form should be uploaded.
 - 5.8. For External Candidates, Entrance exam will be conducted. After payment of fees, download the form. The form should be filled and duly forwarded by respective Head of Department and Head of Institution and the scanned copy of the application form should be uploaded.
 - 5.9. In case the candidate is selected for the course, he/she shall be given admission only if he/she have obtained the permission from his/her employer for doing the MHPE Course
 - 5.10. The candidate should ensure himself/herself about his/her eligibility for the course before filling of the application form.
 - 5.11. The processing fee once received shall neither be refunded nor adjusted for subsequent examination.
 - 5.12. All documents pertaining to eligibility, caste certificate etc. shall be checked in original at time of counselling/admission. **No documents are to be sent to the Controller of Examination office.** Only the scanned copies are to be uploaded during the process of online submission of application form.

6. Admit cards:

- 6.1. Downloadable admit cards will be sent to the applicant candidates on their registered email ids on **19th July 2023 (Wednesday)**. They can download their admit cards and take a print of it to be shown at examination venue.

Admit card can also be obtained in person (in case of inability to download) from **20th July 2023 (Thursday) to 22nd July 2023** between 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM Or on the Entrance Examination Day i.e. **23rd July 2023 (Sunday) from 9.00 AM to 10.00 AM.** from Office of the Controller of Examination, Pariksha Bhawan (PHI), King George's Medical University Lucknow on Payment of Rs.100/-

- 7.1. **Date: 23rd July 2023 (Sunday)**
7.2. **Time: 11:00 AM to 12.30 PM** (90 minutes)
7.3. **Reporting time: 10.00 AM** (60 minutes prior to commencement of Entrance Examination)
7.4. **Venue:** As mentioned on the **Admit Card**.
7.5. **Mode of Examination: MCQs** (Objective/Multiple Choice response Questions) to be answered on Optical Mark Reader Sheet (OMR sheet).
7.6. **Number of questions: 100**
7.7. **Marks:** Every single correct response will get **1.0 mark each**. **No Negative Markings** for incorrect response and/or more than one response.
7.8. **Medium of Examination: English**
7.9. **Syllabus:** Graduate level Applied Human Biology, Basic Ethics and Professionalism in medical profession.

8. Results:

- 8.1. The result will be declared **on the official website of King George's Medical University, Lucknow** and on notice board of Controller of Examinations, Pariksha Bhawan, King George's Medical University, Lucknow.
8.2. The merit list will be prepared of the qualifying examination. A Combined merit list and category wise merit list will be drawn.
8.3. In the event of more than one candidate securing same marks, the merit will be decided on the basis of longest duration of service, older in age, highest number of publications in indexed peer reviewed journals (Pubmed/Scopus)

9. About the Course:

9.1. Admission Procedure

- 9.1.1 **In case the candidate is selected for the course, he/she shall be given admission only if he/she has obtained the permission from his/her employer for doing the MHPE Course**
The selection shall be done by merit list made on the basis of Entrance Examination-2023.
9.1.1 The qualified candidates shall deposit the prescribed fee on the date notified by the University. Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission to the course.
9.1.2 Duration of Course – **This is a part-time, 4 semester course (6 months each).** There will be 6 hours contact sessions each month (total 24 hours/semester) and at least twice the number of hours of self-directed learning.
9.1.3 No leave will be required from the organisation except for the periods of contact sessions
9.1.4 Course type – Part time, onsite course. Dissertation under a course guide will be done from 1st semester. Each candidate will have to participate in one national conference/workshop/seminar on Health Professions Education and conduct one such in KGMU with assistance of the colleagues.

Important

- In case of any dispute, the decision of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, King George's Medical University, Lucknow shall be final.
- In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be Lucknow Courts and Judicature of Allahabad High Court, Lucknow Bench only.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR MASTERS IN HEALTH PROFESSION MEDICAL EDUCATION COURSE (MHPE-2023)

1. Document verification will be performed at the time of admission.
2. Candidates must be medically fit. Additional medical checkup may be done before admission (the candidates who are in the merit list are required to submit certificate of physical fitness).
3. Appearing in the Examination does not automatically mean that the candidate is eligible for the admission. The eligibility shall be decided at the time of Counselling /admission and subsequently by going through original documents.
4. Question shall be based on Medical Subjects, Research Methodology and Ethics etc.
5. Cut off marks for Entrance Examination merit is 50% for Unreserved and 40% for Reserved Category.
6. In the event of more than one candidate securing same marks, the merit will be Decided on the basis of longest duration of service, Older in age, highest number of publications in indexed peer reviewed journals (Pubmed/Scopus)
7. No. T.A. /D.A. will be admissible.
8. Course Fee of Rs. Forty thousand (Rs. 40,000/-) (Rs 10,000 per semester) would be chargeable from all candidates on admission to the course.
9. There is no hostel facility in King George Medical University.
10. Scrutiny of result can be done by depositing Rs. 1000/- by a demand draft in favour of **“COE Entrance Examination”** payable at Lucknow. The request has to be made within 2 working days of declaration of result.
11. **Failure to maintain the discipline and to observe these instructions at the time of examination/admission shall disqualify the candidate from taking the present examination/admission and also from subsequent examinations.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Candidates will be allowed to enter the examination hall only on production of Admit Card.
2. Examination will be of **1 hour 30 minutes** duration and will start at **11.00 AM sharp on 23rd July 2023**.
3. **Reporting time will be 10:00 AM at the Examination centre.**
4. Candidates are required to be present at the examination centre **60 minutes** before the commencement of the examination and to be seated **30 minutes** before the time of examination.
5. **No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre 15 minutes after the seating time.** Candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall only after completion of examination.
6. Candidates shall sign the attendance sheet when directed to do so by the invigilators.
7. Candidates shall not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written matter or bits of paper or any other material except the admit card inside the examination hall. **Pagers, cellular phones, pens, wrist watches and electronic gadgets of any kind are strictly prohibited in the examination hall** and shall be treated as use of unfair means. **Candidates are advised not to bring these to the examination hall as there is no provision for safekeeping.**
8. Candidates shall observe strict silence and attend to their paper. Any disturbance in the examination shall be deemed as misbehaviour and the defaulting candidate shall forfeit the right to continue in the examination hall. The decision of the Centre Superintendent shall be final.
9. **Examination will be on MCQ basis in English language only.**
10. **There will be 100 multiple choice Questions.**
11. **The MCQ has "One Correct option. There shall be no negative marking.**
12. **Candidates shall enter the roll number on the top of the question booklet and nowhere else. Rough work, if any, may be done on the question booklet and not on the response sheet.**
13. Candidate should ensure that the question booklet provided to him/her contains all the pages intact within **10 minutes** of commencement of examination.
14. **The question booklet along with the response sheet will have to be submitted to the Invigilator after the completion of examination.**
15. No candidate should leave his/her seat in the examination hall without the permission of the Invigilator until he/she finally submits the question booklet and response sheet to the invigilator.
16. No candidate shall copy from the paper of any other candidate or permit his/her own papers to be copied or attempt to give/obtain irregular assistance of any description.
17. **The question booklet and response sheet are not to be taken out of the examination hall under any condition.**
18. **USE THE University PROVIDED Blue/Black BALL PEN ONLY**
19. Last copy of OMR sheet will be given to the candidate.
20. Candidate should be careful while filling the circle provided in the OMR Answer sheet and no representation shall be entertained for wrong filling. No correction by overwriting/crossing/use of rubber/whitener is allowed. No marks for such answer will be awarded. There is no negative marking. The answer key shall be uploaded on the **KGMU** website after the declaration of the result.
21. Scrutiny of result can be done by depositing **Rs. 1000/-** by a demand draft in favour of **"COE Entrance Examination"** payable at Lucknow. The request has to be made within **2 working days** of declaration of result.

Failure to maintain the discipline and to observe these instructions at the time of examination/admission shall disqualify the candidate from taking the present examination/admission and also from subsequent examinations.

4. **Eligibility Criteria:**

4.1. Candidate must be an Indian National.

4.2. Minimum educational requirement for admission to this course will be M.A./M.Sc. degree in Psychology / Clinical Psychology or equivalent from a university/deemed university recognized by the UGC with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate.

4.3. Candidates who have appeared in their final qualifying examination and the result is awaited, can apply. They may appear in the written examination but they will have to present passing out certificate at the time of admission.

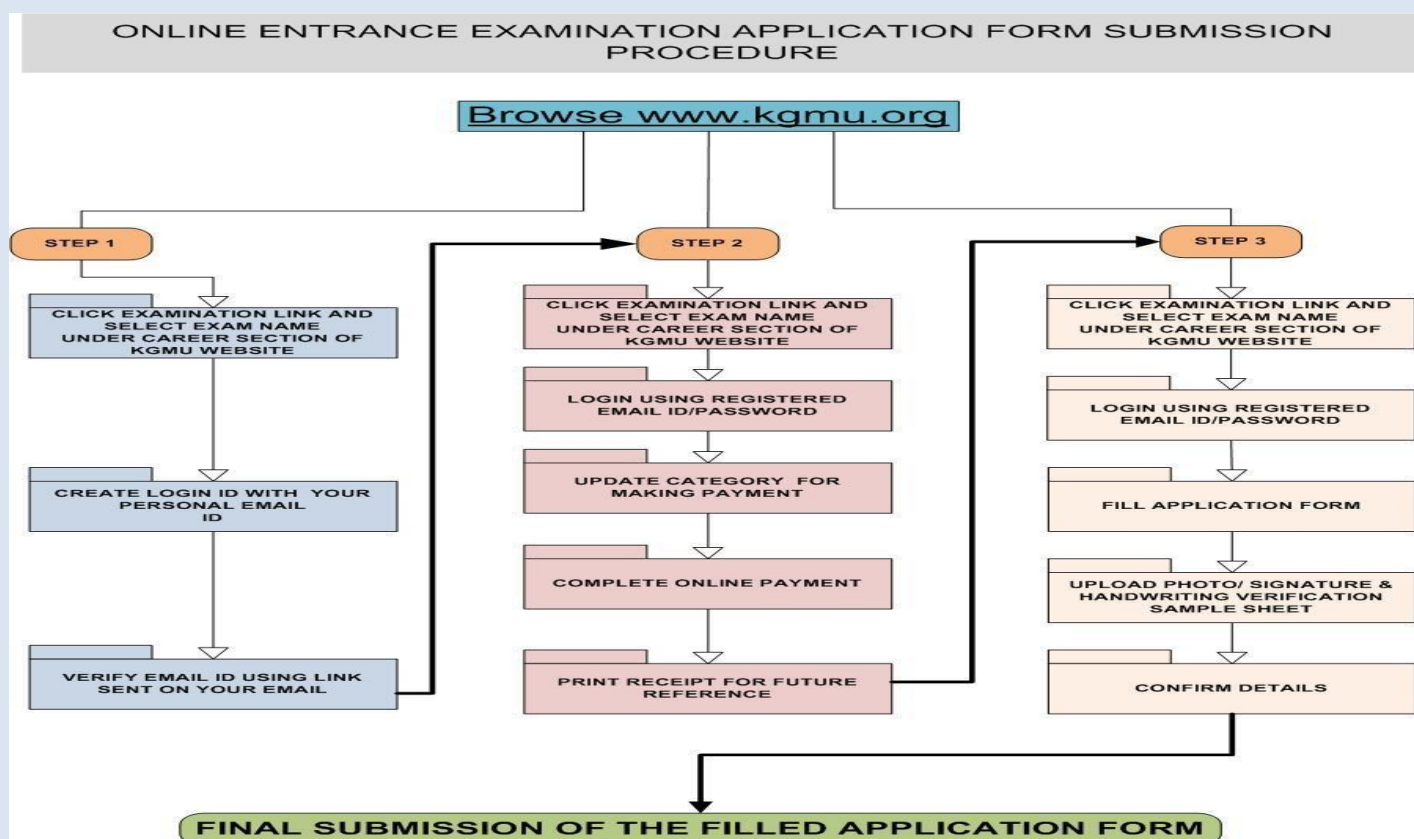

1. Name of Examination: Ph.D. Course Entrance Examination 2023

2. Date & Time of the Examination: 23rd July 2023 (Sunday) at 11:00 AM to 12.30 PM

3. Eligibility Criteria:

- 3.1 Candidate must be an Indian National.
- 3.2 Medical/ Dental Candidates should have MD/MS/MDS degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate in UG.
- 3.3 Non-medical candidates must have graduate and post-graduate degree in subjects related to biomedical sciences/life sciences/science/humanities, with at least 55% marks in aggregate (in PG Degree) or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) as per UGC Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M. Phil/ Ph.D. Degrees Regulations, 2016.
- 3.4 Nursing candidates should have M. Phil (Nursing) or M.Sc. (Nursing) or a Post Graduate degree in nursing recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC). The Candidates should have passed M.Sc. Nursing with a minimum of 55% marks. Candidates should be working in Teaching Institution/ Hospital/ Community Centre.
- 3.5 A relaxation of 5% marks, (from 55% to 50%), or equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ differently able and other categories of candidates as per the decisions of the King George's Medical University, Lucknow from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Masters' Degree prior to 19th Sept. 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures. (As per UGC Minimum standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/ Ph.D. Degrees Regulations, 2016).
- 3.6 The candidate must be employed in extramurally funded project sanctioned to the Guide or Co Guide of King George's Medical University, Lucknow. The project funds should be sanctioned to the King George's Medical University, Lucknow.
- 3.7 Entrance Exam Exemption Criteria: Candidates who have qualified National Eligibility Test conducted by UGC/CSIR/ICMR/DST/DBT/similar government organizations and the fellowship funds from UGC/CSIR/ICMR/DST/similar government organisations should be sanctioned to King George's Medical University, Lucknow, are exempted from appearing in the King George's Medical University- PhD Entrance Examination 2023. These candidates must submit their application and fees through online portal of King George's Medical University- PhD Entrance Examination 2023. A NOC/Consent certificate from an eligible guide of a department has to be provided at the time of counselling, failing which the candidature will be cancelled.

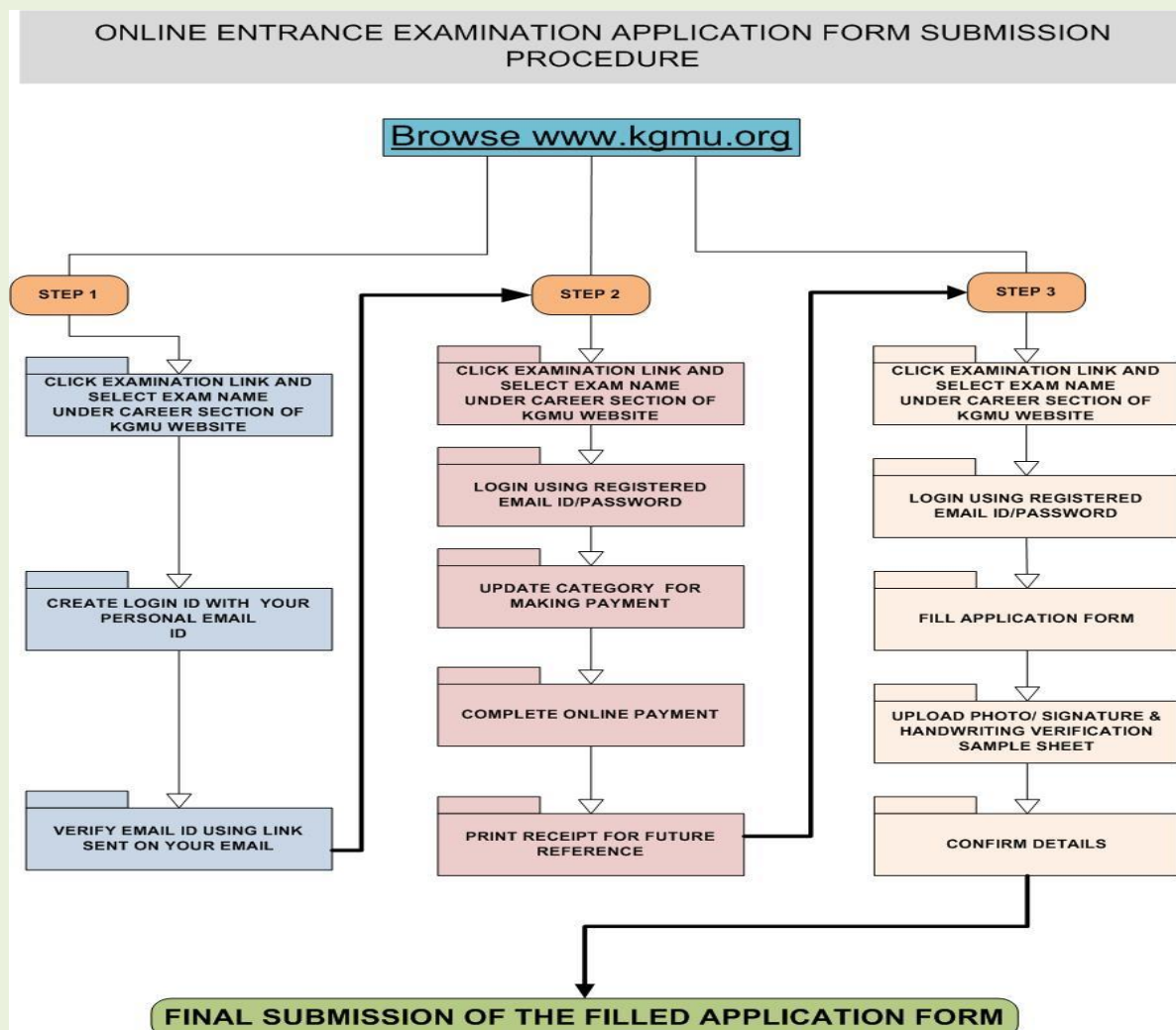

To be selected by Hon'ble VC from a panel of 5 potential faculty members of University proposed by the Guide.

To be selected by Hon'ble VC from a panel of 3 potential experts from outside the University proposed by the Guide.

The Doctoral Committee will be valid for entire duration of work of PhD scholar. Any changes in the Doctoral Committee will need prior approval from the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, King George's Medical University, Lucknow.

- 11.4. The Guide will then arrange for Doctoral Committee Meeting for presentation of synopsis submitted by the Ph.D. Candidate. The guide will send the approved synopsis along with the recommendations of Doctoral Committee (in the prescribed format) to the Research Cell, through the respective Head of department, for approval of the Dean and the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, King George's Medical University, Lucknow.
- 11.5. After approval of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, King George's Medical University, Lucknow, the student will be considered finally registered in the PhD Program of the University.

12. Duration of the Ph.D. Programme

- 12.1. Ordinarily the Ph.D. programme will be for a minimum period of three years from the date of final registration.
- 12.2. Candidates who do not submit their thesis within 6 years after registration will be removed from PhD program of the King George's Medical University, Lucknow, unless the Doctoral Committee recommends otherwise.

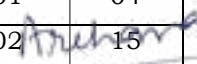

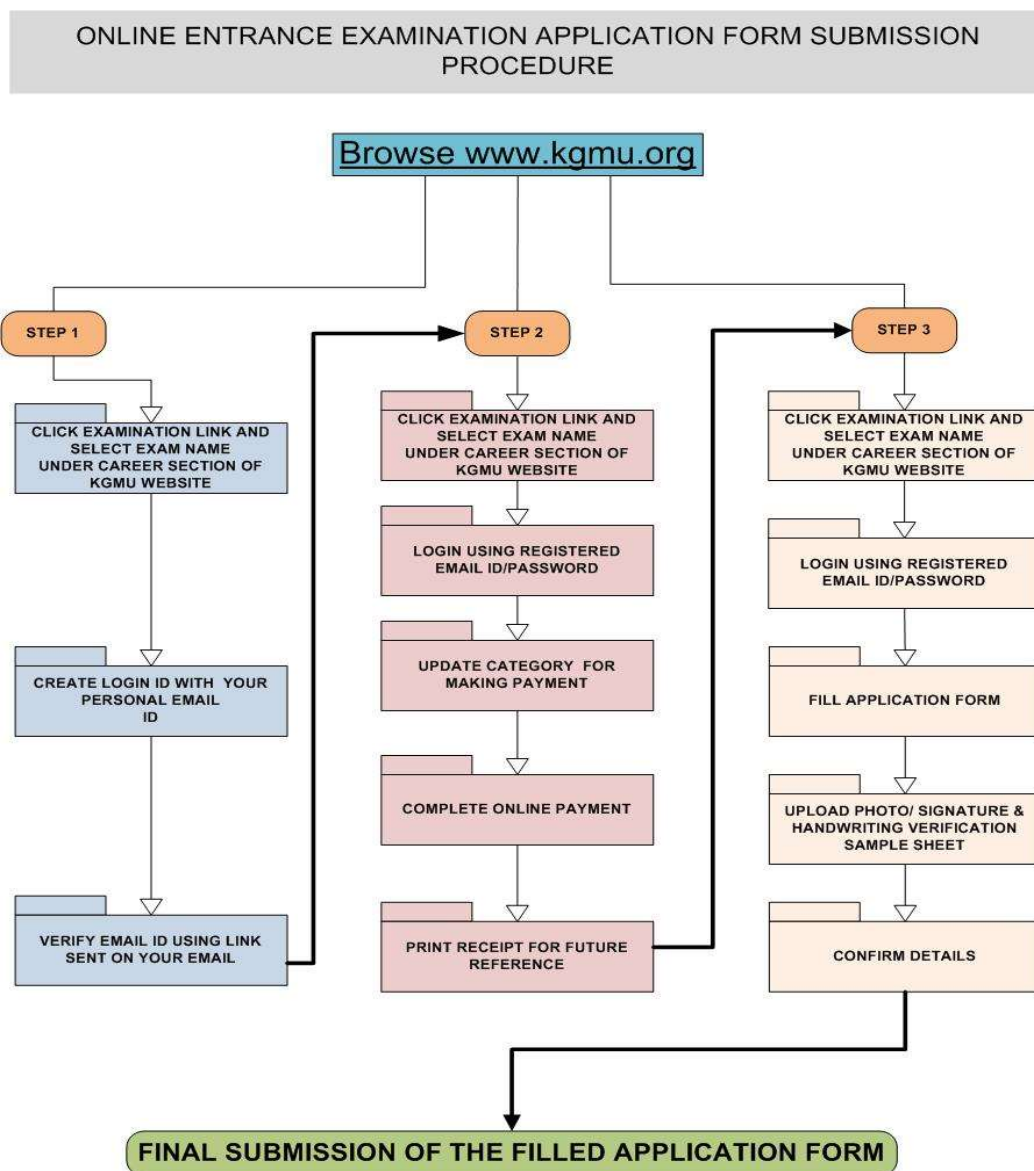

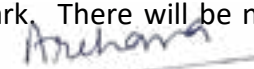

4. Subject to the advertisement of vacancies and screening formalities, the test will be based on the written exam of 100 marks which will consist of broad speciality-based subject specific questions; questions of MBBS level and questions based on medical ethics and professionalism, medical education, research methodology, biomedical waste management etc. The duration of examination shall be 01:30 hours. Each question will carry 01 (one) mark. There will be no negative marking.


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5. **Minimum qualifying marks :**

The candidates will be declared successful in this entrance examination if they fulfil the passing criteria as per NMC as defined below

As per Medical Council of India, Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 (Amended up to May, 2018) :

The Clause 9 subclause III. under the heading 'SELECTION OF POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS, as amended vide notification No. MCI.18(1)/2010- Med/49070 dated 21st December 2010, following shall be substituted as under, in terms of Notification dated 15.02.2012:-

"In order to be eligible for admission to any postgraduate course in a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in 'National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test for Postgraduate courses' held for the said academic year. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates as provided in clause 9(II) above with locomotory disability of lower limbs, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile. The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the All-India common merit list in 'National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test for Postgraduate courses.

6. Overall and category wise list of candidates shall be prepared on basis of written marks. The appointment letter will be issued by **Medical Superintendent** after counselling where all original documents will be verified.

6. Candidate will be responsible for checking their own eligibility. Merely appearing in exam does not confer eligibility. Documents shall be verified at the time of counselling and if found void/lacking the candidature of the candidate will automatically be cancelled. Additionally, he may be debarred for subsequent examination.

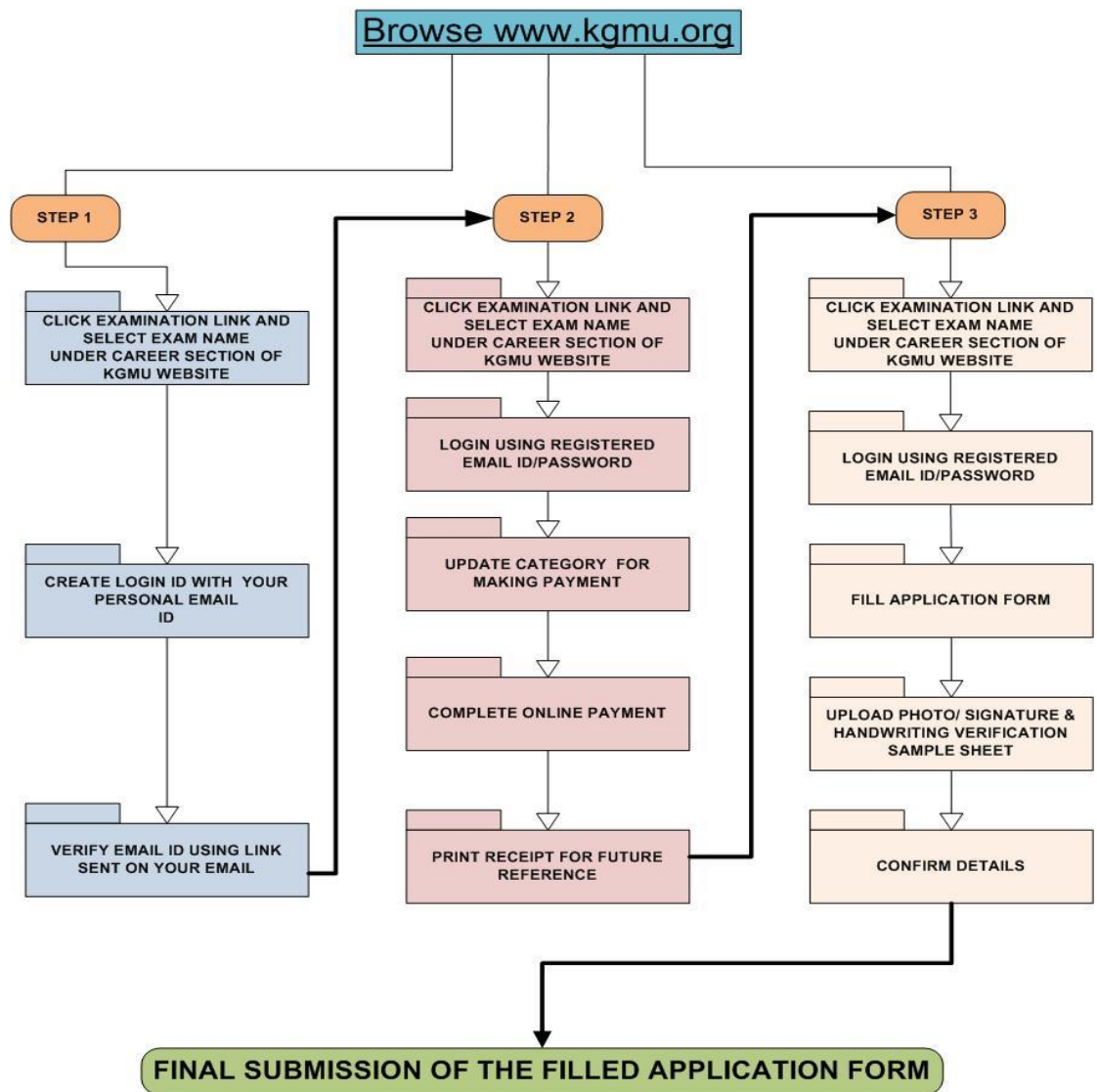

1. The Department of Hospital Administration, KGMU was sanctioned course of Master in Hospital Administration (MHA 2017) by AICTE, after necessary inspection.
