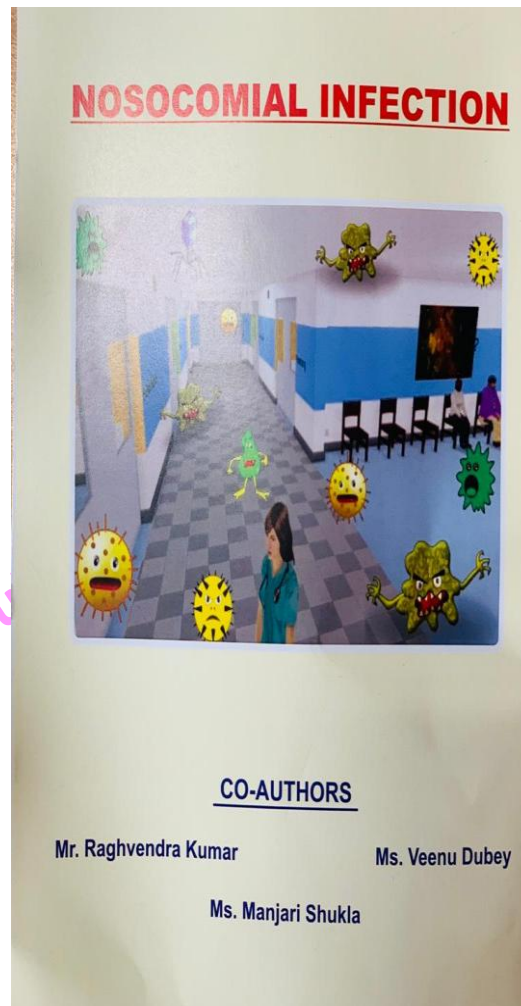
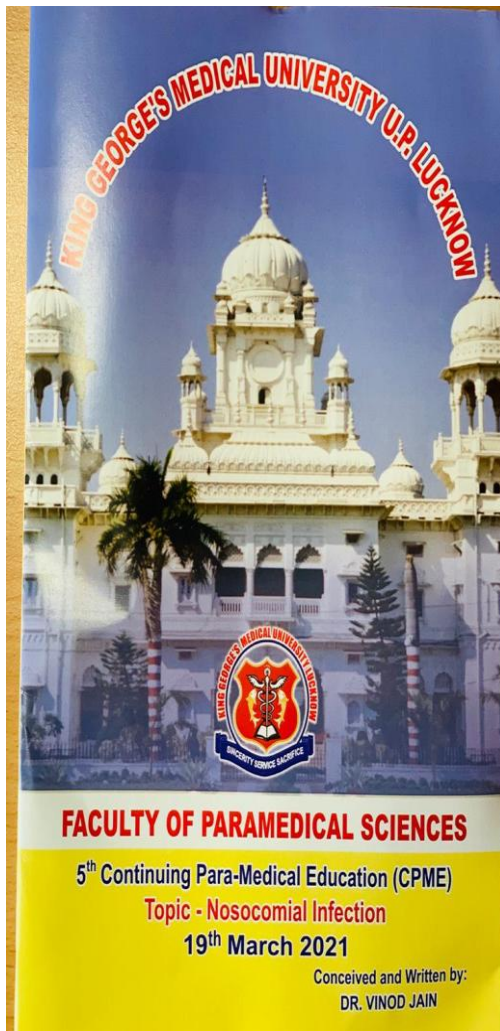
<p><b>POISON</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Avoid any danger to yourself and others.</li> <li>Immediately call for EMS 108.</li> <li>Wipe all poison away from person's body.</li> <li>Hold on the poison container and preserve material if available.</li> <li>Do not induce vomit to victim if the poison substance is corrosive.</li> <li>Do not give 2 table spoon of salt in one glass of water for inducing vomiting if poison is non corrosive.</li> <li>Take care of airway.</li> </ul>	<p><b>BURN</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove person from dangerous zone to safe zone.</li> <li>Immediately call for EMS 108.</li> <li>If the burn is superficial cool affected area with running water for up to 20 min.</li> <li>Do not break the blisters.</li> <li>If the burn is severe or all over the body cover the victim with clean sterile blanket or bed sheet.</li> <li>Remove all the tight clothing, jewellery, rings unless sticking to skin.</li> </ul>	<p><b>HEART ATTACK</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognize and help the victim to a comfortable position.</li> <li>Immediately call for EMS 108.</li> <li>Assist the victim and immediately give prescribed medicine.</li> <li>If the victim is unconscious start CPR if required.</li> </ul> 
<p><b>BRAIN STROKE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognize the victim having stroke with severe headache, facial asymmetries, drooping of excessive saliva, unconsciousness.</li> <li>Immediately call for EMS 108.</li> <li>Help the person in to a comfortable position with head and shoulder supported.</li> <li>If the person is conscious do not give anything to eat or drink.</li> <li>If the person is unconscious start CPR if required.</li> </ul>	<p><b>FRACTURE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Verify scene and safety and immediately call for medical help 108.</li> <li>Keep victim calm and help them to find the most comfortable position.</li> <li>Immediately immobilize the broken part with the help of applying slings and splints.</li> <li>Try to reduce the pain and support the injured area.</li> <li>If there is bleeding apply pressure bandage control it.</li> </ul>	<p><b>BLEEDING</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep victim calm as well as yourself.</li> <li>Immediately call for EMS 108.</li> <li>Apply direct pressure if the bleeding is non severe with the help of two fingers.</li> <li>If the bleeding is severe and in flowing manner apply the compression bandaging by using the clean cloth or bandage.</li> <li>Raise and support the injured part above the heart or elevation of the part.</li> <li>In catastrophic bleeding apply Tourniquets and mention time.</li> </ul>
<p><b>EPILEPSY/SEIZURES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognize the victim and verify scene and safety.</li> <li>Call for medical help 108.</li> <li>Protect the victim from injury by removing all obstructions.</li> <li>Place the victim on their side to allow saliva and vomit drain out.</li> <li>Do not put anything in the victim's mouth. Monitor any further injury.</li> <li>Assess the victim if it has repeat of seizures and call the medical help as required.</li> </ul>	<p><b>CHOKING</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognize the victim of choking.</li> <li>Call for medical help 108.</li> <li>Perform Heimlich Manoeuvre.</li> <li>Stand behind the victim.</li> <li>Place the thumb side of one fist against the victim's abdomen between the navel and the ribs.</li> <li>Grasp your fist with your other hand.</li> <li>Press in to the abdomen with a quick upward thrust.</li> <li>Repeat 5 times until the object is expelled or medical help arrives.</li> </ul> 	<p><b>BASIC LIFE SUPPORT</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The technique for giving emergency first aid treatment to save the life.</li> <li>Cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR).</li> <li>Verify scene and safety.</li> <li>Activate the EMS 108.</li> <li>Check Responsiveness and pulse (carotid) and breathing in 5 to 10 sec.</li> <li>Before giving breathing clear the airway by performing jaw thrust - chin lift manoeuvre.</li> <li>Perform chest compression and breathing as 30:2.</li> <li>Push hard and push fast.</li> <li>Provide 100 to 120 chest compression per minute with the depth of at least 5 cm in adults.</li> <li>Try to minimize the interruptions provide complete recoil of the chest.</li> </ul>

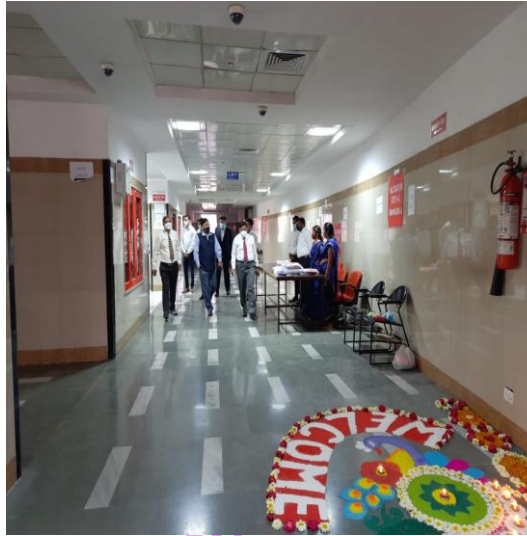

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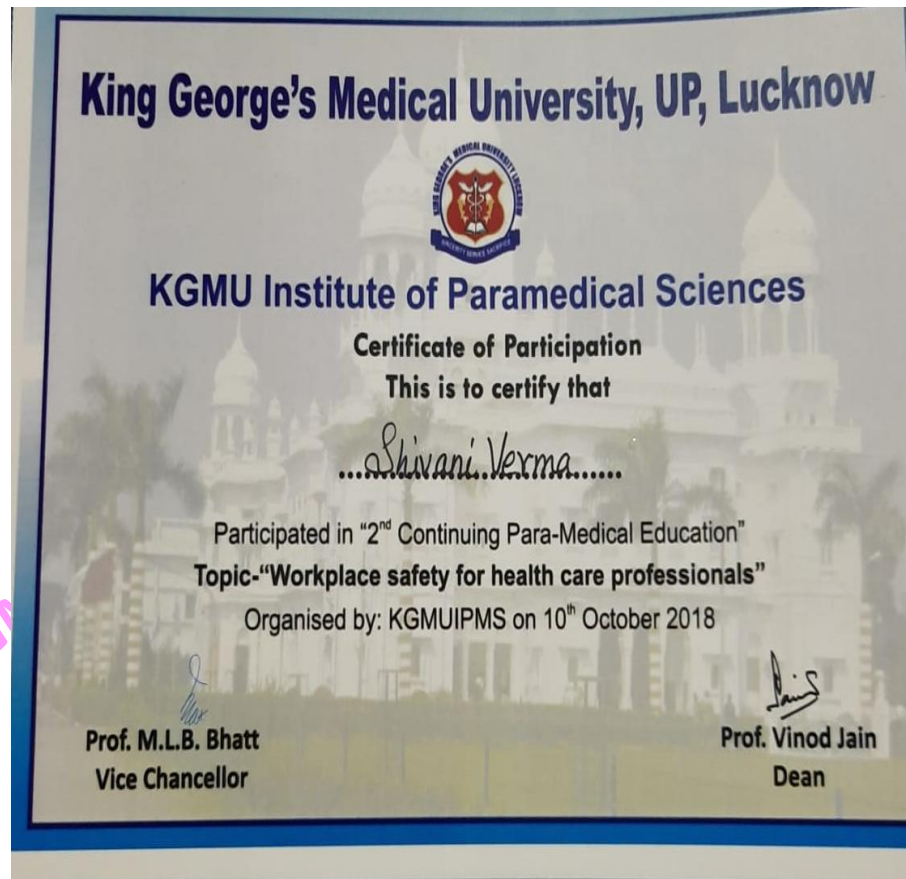
