Meeting of board of studies of CVTS department was held on 05.08.2021 at 12:00 Noon and was attended by the following faculty:

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the board of studies.
The following points were discussed:

1. Regular rotation of our MCh CVTS Resident as per MCI/NMC norms to the Cardiology Department during the 2nd & 3rd year of his/her training for exposure to cardiological procedures like Echo, Cath Lab, etc.
2. Dr. Zeeshan Hakim is our MCh candidate. His thesis entitled "A Study Of Peri-Operative Arterial Lactate, CRP, Neutrophil Count And Neutrophil To Lymphocyte Ratio In Patients Undergoing Surgery With Cardiopulmonary Bypass" is to be submitted this year and he would be sitting his exams in 2022. A departmental review of his thesis was undertaken and found to be good. Timely submission of the thesis by Dr. Zeeshan Hakim would be done.
3. Our centre does a large number of valvular heart surgeries and we have a large patient pool of follow up patients who come from remote areas for INR monitoring, etc. It would be a great help for these patients if their problems could be addressed at the grassroot level and so it was thought that the training of interested doctors who would be equipped with appropriate knowledge to provide such basic services at the patients' local places would effectively help with the large burden.
It was thought that the starting of a PDCC course in the "Post operative management of Valvular Heart Diseases" would serve such a purpose. Dr. Vivek will be involved with the layout of PDCC course which will be forwarded to the academic Council of KGMU, Lucknow for approval.
4. A research project by our department on a "Novel and Cost-Effective Technique for Tricuspid Annuloplasty" has been going on. Despite the pandemic an adequate number of cases have been done which fulfil research criteria. We now



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plan to start the compilation of data of our patients and work towards completing this novel study and share our findings.


- CVTS department has made its MCh course curriculum with the help of MCI/NMC guidelines. We shall be soon updating this on the website.
