Subjects: *Request for proposals for Intramural Short Term Medical Research Fellowship (2019) for undergraduate students.*

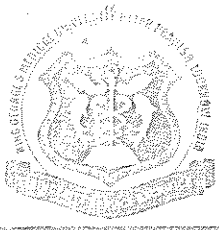
University is focused on research. In order to inculcate high quality research work culture and develop human resource, intra-mural short-term medical research fellowship for students is one of important programs that research cell undertakes every year. Research proposals are invited in field of clinical medicine preferably with linkages to basic sciences from medical undergraduate students. The proposal must be developed with a faculty mentor with commitment to work with student. *One faculty member can mentor two students per year.* Likewise students must do this work as a part of research training in their free time or during vacations. Research Cell will also facilitate linkages with extra-mural scientists of eminence in given area of work. Any registered undergraduate student of medical university whose term is valid for at least 6 months from 1.07.2019 is eligible to apply for fellowship. Funds will not usually be provided for either add-ons or augmentation of ongoing projects or for purchase of equipment or for unrelated departmental activities.

Projects must take advantage of existing infra-structure and human resource in cost-effective manner. Amount of funding and number of fellowships awarded will depend upon merit of submissions. Selections for funding will be made after competitive evaluation. Maximum 100 fellowships will be available.

Please submit the proposals in no more than 10 pages (Font Times New Roman, Size 12, single space with 2 cm margins all round), which must have the following sections:

- Background & Rationale
- Objectives
- Methods (please include setting, study design, participant selection, intervention or Investigative procedures if any, variables with their definition and measurements, sample size, data management and analysis)
- Written commitment from intramural faculty to dedicate time-to-time mentoring.
- Time frame (maximum permissible is 18 weeks or 90 working days)
