Time Schedule for the Extended Mop-Up Round UP Neet UG -2021

Time Schedule for the Admission Through Extended Mop-Up round in the State of Uttar Pradesh for Government and Private Medical/Dental Colleges /Institutions/ Universities for Graduate (MBBS/BDS) is as follows:-

Date of Allotment Government Medical/Dental College	26th April 2022 (From 11:00 AM)
Date of Allotment Private Medical College	26th April 2022 (From 02:00 PM)
Admission date	On Spot

- 1- It is mandatory for the candidates to be present at the counseling venue at 10:00 am for government sector seats and 01:00 pm for private sector seats.
- 2- Only those candidates are eligible for extended mop-up round, who has already register for mop-up round (23-03-2022 to 26-03-2022) and his/her name in the merit list of mop-up round.
- 3- Extended Mop-up round would be conducted at Kalam Center in KGMU Lucknow.
- 4- Only Those Candidates are eligible for Extended Mop-up round who have not been allotted MBBS Seats in first and Second and Mop-Up round of UP Neet UG-2021 Counseling.
- 5- Candidates who have been allotted/Admitted /Not Joined/resigned from MBBS Seat in first, Second and Mop-Up round Counseling will not be eligible for the Extended Mop-up round.
- 6- Those candidates who have been already admitted in BDS course can participate in the Extended Mop-Up round to upgrade thier course to MBBS after resign from thier seats.
- 7- Those Candidates are not eligible for Extended Mop-Up round, who has already admitted in any Medical College of India through any State/All India counseling in NEET UG 2021
- 8- Candidates should have the Bank DD of Rs 30,000/- for government (MBBS/BDS) seats and Rs. 200,000/- for Private Medical College seats in favour of **Director General Medical Education & Training U.P payable at Lucknow,** as a security fee (**Only CTS Bank DD will be accepted,** cash should not accepted.
- 9- Candidates should complete their admission process by submitting thier original documents on spot after allotment.
- 10- Candidates will have to produce certificates in original as well as one self attested photo copies of all documents at the time verification otherwise they will not be allowed to participate in Extended Mop-Up round.
- 11- **Candidates who wish to opt the seats in Private Medical College can prepare the DD in advance for tution fee amount of Rs. 10.50 Lacs and security + hostel fee of 4.5 Lacs in favor of Director General Medical Education & training U.P payable at Lucknow. (Only CTS Bank DD will be accepted.**
- 12- After allotment candidates should deposit difference of tution fee amount **online to the allotted/admitted Medical College or Director General Medical Education & training U.P.**

- 13- Extended Mop-up round will be conducted up to availability of the seats.
